We now have a new Principial. He is Mr. Clinton D. Ohilips, he replaces Mr. Pius B. James who now teaches in the government school where he put more time and comes to school very late many days. Pray with us for the teachers to be able to get a good pay as the Government continues to increase their teachers salaries. We pray that our teachers will understand our conditions and help the kids to get a good education. They too need to be encouraged."



**Jesus Loves Me Home**— Tom was able to visit while he was in Haiti. I was so excited to learn that Clotide has started a "chicken project"! We have talked about this for several years and I'm happy she is trying it! There is one new little boy at the home. The government brought him to JLMH from Port-au-Prince. There are many repairs that need to be made and new mattresses and other things that need to be purchased. Also school is starting and they need \$2000 to buy school supplies and new uniforms!

## Tom's Trip To Haiti

The church of Jesus Christ is alive and well and serving him faithfully in Haiti! Thank you so much for your prayers, God answered them with a resounding "yes." Thank you, once more, to all of you who have given of your time and your resources to meet the spiritual and physical needs of our Lord's kingdom in Haiti. God has done good things with your gifts and your prayers.



The leaders with whom I worked – Sainsurin Jean Baptiste in Gonaives and Jean Joseph St. Juste in Promised Land – are men of God. They take seriously their responsibility to coordinate and communicate with the preachers in their area. It was easy to see that they are highly regarded. Their respect for Reggie Thomas is great; and well earned, I might add. I am thankful that God allowed me time to have quality discussions with both men, and to develop a rapport and budding friendship.

It is wonderful to report to you that Haitian believers are stepping out in generosity to care for the poor among them. I learned from Sainsurin of a plan that his church has adopted. Led by God, with the approval of his church elders, Sainsurin challenged those in the congregation who have steady incomes to give a special monthly offering to help those who struggle daily to find food. Over 40 Christians are willing to give monthly to this fund. They plan to give food and, also, to provide a chance for them to develop an income. The plan begins this month. Please pray that our Father will bless this step of faith.

My task included training preachers. I held two-day seminars in both areas and taught about 55 men. (Attendance at my second stop was affected by the approach of Tropical Storm Emily – more on that later.) The comments and questions I received make it clear that the seminars were effective. "Your teaching is worth \$10,000 in my pocket." "I came for two days, but you have given me two weeks' worth of study."

## Tom's Trip To Haiti



Our study topics included: Sexual Purity (from Proverbs), overcoming temptation and the Holy Spirit. Our Haitian brothers were very gracious, cooperative and kind.

Although rain hampered our schedule, I was able to preach the gospel during four evening meetings. Thirteen precious souls responded to Christ's invitation, and we had the privilege of sharing in their baptisms. The Caribbean Sea is a beautiful baptistery!

Coby Russell (the 16 year-old young man who accompanied me) was able to do construction work, participate in English lessons, share in ad-hoc medical treatment (a construction accident), spend time with orphans and share his testimony. We had some excellent time for bonding: fun talks about life, understanding other cultures, and how God works in people's lives. We also spent a lot of time discussing driving in Haiti – it would make a challenging video game!

A brief visit to the Jesus Loves Me Home helped to round out my first experience with Haiti. This is a ministry of love through and through. It is wonderful to see how the love of God makes such a difference in the lives of children who would have every disadvantage this world can offer. Cooperation between our Haitian house parents, Prospere and Clotide, and Lori Darnell pays present and eternal dividends.

Our return to the States proved to be an adventure, as Tropical Storm Emily approached Haiti. Learning of weather reports, we determined to cut short our last seminar and head to Port au Prince early. The farewell prayer time we shared with our Haitian brothers was something special. Ominous rain clouds continued to build as we drove to the capital. Haitian contacts informed us that the airport hotel was full. Lori Darnell helped us locate another ministry's guesthouse, where we spent the night (aren't cell phones wonderful?) We experienced one storm "false start" and kept waiting for the other shoe to drop (vast quantities of rain drops), yet it remained dry and threatening the next morning. Our flight was delayed by nearly four hours. Waiting in an airport terminal stuffed with people, ours was the first of three departures. We learned state-side that those three were the only ones to leave for some time. Not quite according to schedule, we made it home safe and sound. And we owe our safety to the intercession of God's people. It seems that Emily did not materialize as expected, which is great news for Haitians. Thank you for your prayers.

Greetings. We thanked God for his amazing protection and the safety He has given to both of you during that terrible tornado. Of course the amazing provision that God has provided for you to rebuild everything you lost. May God pour the abundant blessings back to those individual or group who love you both dearly and volunteered their time to help work to clear everything. Thanks God and thanks for the detailed updates.

My family is doing good. The ICA is blessed with 76 students as of June 17 and there might be more coming. I hope no more because we lack rooms and offices. We might divide the canteen or utilize the third floor. We were able also to install air condition unit in the lower grade and plan to continue installing to other levels one at a time.

We rented a house in front of the school or church for our new teachers and some parents who need a room closer to the ICA. The room is free for our teachers who are far from Bohol but we charge parents who needs a room. Send you later some pictures when the school started.

For main time I send pictures for you to see the first time DVBS in Camiguin Island that we started May 31 to June 4, 2011. We plan to bring 5 DVBS group by next year to conduct a 10 days DVBS program in two places in all 5 existing municipalities around the Camiguin Island. Please include us and our plans in your prayers. We also would like to conduct preaching in every place we will have DVBS. Please help us pray to be able to find a good place to rent for this new work and also special request to please help us find a dedicated preacher to stay permanently in this new outreach in Camiguin Island.


## Reggie & Esther Returning To Guadeloupe After 22 Years

crowds in attendance. It was "standing room" only with many standing on the outside looking in. The only disappointment was that no one came to surrender their lives to Jesus.

Worst of all some of the main leaders of the church are involved in sin which brings great disgrace upon the church in the community.

I decided after prayer to confront the situation by preaching on LOVE using the words of Jesus from Matthew 22 as the text. I carefully pointed out many of the main scriptures in the New Testament dealing with Christian love, and then I used Jesus as the greatest example of love. I used the Apostle Paul as a good example. My third point was to ask each member to search his or her heart and ask, "Have I been showing Christian love or have I been a part of sin, bringing division and hate into the church?"

I called upon everyone involved to repent and seek God's forgiveness and the forgiveness of one another.

There were around 75 souls who came forward during the nightly meetings and this Sunday morning and publicly asked for forgiveness and rededicated their lives to Christ.

We had been told that very few would partake of the Lord's Supper because of the hate and ill will among the members. However just before the Lord's Supper one of the elderly ladies of the church stepped forward and gave a personal testimony. She testified how she had been a part of the hating and dividing group and that she had refused to speak to some of the members. She publicly asked forgiveness and said she would apologize personally to each member she had offended. This testimony really touched the entire congregation and supported my sermon.

We then reverently observed the Lord's Supper. Many did abstain because when they examined their hearts they were convicted by the sin they were guilty of. We pray this conviction will bring repentance and restoration. We pray that those of the leadership of the church who are immoral will repent. We are sorry to report that the leaders who have caused all the sin by their actions have not yet repented.

## The Christian Church On Marie Gallante

### THE CHRISTIAN CHURCH ON MARIE GALLANTE

It is doubtful that you have ever heard of Marie Gallante. It is even more doubtful that you could point to it on a world map. Marie Gallante is one of 7 French Island nations located in the general area of the Caribbean, although the Atlantic Ocean divides at the juncture of Guadeloupe and becomes the Caribbean Sea on the western side. As Marie Gallante lies on the Eastern side of Guadeloupe it is technically in the Atlantic Ocean.

White Fields Overseas Evangelism has labored throughout its 46 year history to establish Churches that are un-denominational and that follow the Bible only in the unreached nations of the world. Therefore we have planted New Testament churches in Jamaica, Cuba, Haiti, Dominican Republic, St. Martin, Antigua, St. Lucia, Trinidad, Tobago, French Guiana, Suriname, Guyana, Curacao, Guadeloupe, and now Marie Gallante. All these 15 nations are in the part of the world known as the Caribbean.

During our most recent effort in Marie Gallante we worked with a member of the Guadeloupe Christian Church named Maurice Paul. Brother Paul told us that during his years as a member of the Guadeloupe Church he had often noted that some members of the church had moved to Marie Gallante. He felt the leading of the Holy Spirit to check up on these members. He traveled at his own expense to Marie Gallante and searched. One by one he found the members and in each case found that they had become discouraged and backslidden. Brother Paul met with these members each Friday evening. He would take a boat after work and sail to Marie Gallante and meet with these members teaching them the Bible and praying with them.

Reggie and Esther have been meeting with these former members of the Guadeloupe Christian Church for the past week. We have conducted a revival meeting with them. The attendance each night was very encouraging. All 17 Christians attended the meeting plus their friends and neighbors. Each night saw 60 or more attending. The meetings were held in a tent on the front lawn of the house that has been rented as a meeting place for the new congregation.
