I am happy to inform you that we had the Vacation Bible School for our Orphanage children (10 No's) from 12th to 16th a total of five days. They had good time in their holidays converted like holly days, learning bible verses and beautiful parables from New Testament, praise songs, everything they enjoyed. We praise God and thank for the privilege He blessed. My wife Mary and children had taken special interest along with me.

I wish to inform you about the present condition of India and our state Andhra Pradesh. With a long great agitation for six month, the state Andhra Pradesh is divided into two states i.e. Andhra Pradesh – Our living state and Telangana – Newly formed state. Our state Andhra Pradesh consist 13 districts including Tirupathi and Telangana with 10 Districts. The Hyderabad is made on condition for 10 years as united Head quarters to both the states i.e., Capital. This unwilling situation was headed by Mrs. Sonia Gandhi, the largest congress party. For this reason the entire people are against to congress and the general elections are conducted on 7th of May 2014 and are the results are announced on 16th of May and the people voted against congress and as a result both in National and in state BJP- Bharitiya Janatha party won and came into force and its supporting party came in state TDP Telugu Desam Party. The fact I want to tell you, this sort of government is against to Christian's and Muslims, the God only is our shield to protect Christianity. The Prophecy of Revelations are about to come. Even at JNL orphanage the boar well water supply was very less, it will be better if we deepen the well in this summer. We pray God to facilitate with good rains. White Fields Evangelist Steven Enoch Reports From Liberia, Africa



We write to report on our trip to Kinjor, Liberia, where we conducted a Campaign for Jesus Crusade. We thank you first of all for your prayers and support to us here in Charity Church of Christ International, Logan Town Liberia. We arrived in Kinjor at the hour of 4:30 P.M in a rented pick up truck. We began the crusade on Wednesday the 28th on May in Rock Village, New Kinjor, where the Company is moving all the people from the old Town because the town is situated on a gold deposit that has been mined for over forty years. The new Town is divided into two Camps. The one where we had the Crusade was Chocolate City and the other one New England.

That night, the 28th of May we only baptized 7 persons because the people were suspicious and reluctant as they did not know we were there only to preach the gospel of Christ. The next day we were called to go the main town where most of the people were living. On the 29th of May we baptized 32 persons. The people told us it was the first time they had ever heard the gospel of Christ. They promised to call the villagers to come in the evening. That was the night of the great rain and we were not able to continue our service. The total attendance for these two services was 535.

On Friday afternoon, a little girl called Mema was attacked by six demons while I was resting in the afternoon before going for the service. I was called to go to the school campus a girl was dying.

I did not know what was happening. I went with some of the Team members and we prayed for her and the demons left. . you will see her in her blue and white uniform lying on her back before me. Her mother was supposed to bring her in the service for more prayers but she did not and the rain gave her a big excuse. Please pray for Grand Cape Mount County. The people there are lost and the majority without Christ. They need Christian churches there.

We promised to go back in the dry season. This time we pray to go with a Preacher that

will remain there for the starting of a new church. I am presently sending four men to a Bible College here for training to be prepared for any place as the Lord will chooses. Please pray with me as the desire is there but the funding is not always there.

God bless you all for your prayers and support to us. Thanks again and have a Godly day.

Jesus Loves Me Home



There is a new (to this side of the world) virus sweeping the Caribbean and entering in the United States. The chikungunya virus has mostly stayed in Africa until now. Once it arrived in the Caribbean it has quickly spread to almost epidemic proportions.

Chikungunya is spread by mosquitoes. It is not deadly by itself. So far medical people have said you can only catch it once. It lasts about a week. Chikungunya gives you a high fever, headache, muscle pain, vomiting, and very, very painful joints.

Even the name "chikungunya" means "bent over in pain". The reports from people who have this virus are the pain is so bad you do feel like you are dying. There is no treatment for this virus, only pain reliever and hydration.



This virus can become deadly in a place like Haiti. The vomiting and dehydration is the only reason why. At the time of writing up the newsletter I received an urgent call from Francius Joseph: "Lori, Clotide asked me to call. Seven of the children at the home are very sick with Chikungunya . They are very weak. The little ones cannot move their bodies. They are in very bad pain. They are very dehydrated and cannot eat. They are very weak. They need to go to the hospital!" 4 of the sickest children include Taicha (Rebecca), Christina (A new, unhealthy baby), Dobbins and Cindzy. These are our smallest children. They have not been able to eat for days. This is dangerous for them. Please pray for them. Pray for the other 3 who also have the virus that they may not get as sick. Pray for the other kids that they do not get bit and catch the virus at all!

This is really scary for us and for Clotide and Prospere. We will also need help with hospital bills. We are not set up for hospital visit especially when it involves 4 children. I do not know what the cost will be, but if you feel lead to help a little extra, please do so.



What I wanted to be telling you this month is that we have a new baby at the Jesus Loves Me Home. I will tell you her whole story next month. For now she was found on the streets of Gonaives. She is malnourished, has worms and scabies, she has other easily treated problems. But in Haiti, nothing is easy and now she has the Chikungunya virus. Please pray for Baby Christina.



A Prayer Request For The Raboteau Christian Church In Gonaives, Haiti



This month of July a two man team consisting of Evangelist Larry Jamison and Elder Lem Palmer will travel to Haiti for the purpose of surveying the buildings and property of the Christian Church at Raboteau in Haiti. They plan to take measurements and go to the lumber yards to seek necessary materials which will lead to their return trip in January to put a new roof on the Church buildings.

This congregation was started by Evangelist Reggie Thomas in the year 1973. Reggie's brother Ed, built the first building. 20 years later a group of men from the Villa Heights Christian Church in Joplin re-roofed the building. Now 40 years after the church was first started, Larry and Lem will go to re-roof it for the 2nd time. However this project will involve more than just re-roofing the building. It will also involve tying together 3 buildings and join-



ing them under one roof. The church has grown and also the church has a Christian School with 375 students who attend daily. The buildings are used 7 days a week. So this is a very important and very expensive project. Please pray for Larry and Lem and pray for the preacher Francius Joseph, who was one of the original orphans at the Mapou Christian Orphanage, now known as JESUS LOVES ME HOME.

The Invisible Ministry

One Sunday I visited a church that was known to be a supporter of White Fields. Because it was my first visit, I began to look around and get acquainted. I noticed that the church was designed so that when people exited from the main auditorium they faced a wall size display of important issues. I was pleased to see that right in the middle, where it couldn't be missed. It was a good sized "White Fields" display. The first people that I met were young people coming out of class. I introduced myself to one, as "Blythe Robinson from White Fields." They said "good to have you" and walked away. I went into the auditorium and said the same thing to an adult. They asked "what is White Fields?" I replied, "it's a mission organization." They said "that's good" and walked away. Another person's response was, "sorry but I never heard of them," as they walked away. After several such encounters, I look over my shoulder to make sure that the White Fields display could be easily seen, because I was beginning to wonder if it was invisible. I concluded that it must be

invisible to many people.

I've found similar responses about many of my newsletters. The tipoff is when they ask about a subject that was previously announced in them. This issue is not just here, nor just White Fields, but "Missions" in general. The question is why? Jesus seems to have encountered the same situation when He said, "having eyes you see not" [Mk.8:18]. It seems to have taken the Apostles 10 years to see the need for "missions" among the Gentiles [Acts10]. Sadly many of His disciples still don't see that need. After considering many possible explanations as to the "why" of all of this occurs, I returned to my theory of "the invisible Ministry."

Missions is something that must be experienced, not read about, otherwise it's not real to that person. Our personal lives are defined by our world of experiences. Who do we know, who do we talk to and keep in touch with, whose lives are real and important to us? This seem to even affect the intensity of our prayers for others. Finally I concluded that all of this often applies to Christ and His word. Peter wrote about this in I Pet. 1:7-8: "...Jesus Christ, Whom having not seen, you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory." Whatever it is that makes Christ real to us, is that which will make "Missions" real to us. It's simply because we love Him who first loved us [I Jn.4:19] and was willing to pay any price to seek and save the lost [Lk.19:10] and that's us. Jesus said, "If you love me you will keep my commandments" [Jn.14:23]. The "invisible ministry" becomes visible when we love Him.

These days were very disappointing for us. Georgy is working like crazy, working the work of 5 people who are not working - just receiving the salary of one. And he is having the smallest salary. The boss takes 1/4 from his salary and says: "if you have a problem with this you can resign the work, He knows Georgy cannot find another work.



Also our government is almost bankrupt, they are doing this purposely, as they keep us independent of Russia. They got a big loan and steal the money. Many sectors are blocked, many hospitals don't have doctors as they went to work in western Europe. My friend from childhood died a few days ago, just 41 years old, with 2 little children, he felt not well, called the hospital but they didn't have a doctor in this time and he died. We were on the way for school and a crazy driver didn't stop on the walkway and he almost hit us, Rebeka and Anabela were so scared.

The only hope is in our God and his word. Bulgaria is in ruins as people don't believe in God. Almost everyone just steals and lies.

I'm continuing with Sunday school in the church and teaching the Bible at my home.

Sorry for so much bad news. Your friendship and Christian love and care help me and mean so much to me. Its good to know we are not alone and we are part of lovely Christian family. And one day we will be together in better place with our God for ever.
