Lots of news this week, two years ago Haiti built a new university between Cap Haitian and Wanamete. There is also a large student housing village, and probably 300 homes that were built to house people from the Port au Prince earthquake. Every time I went past the area I thought, WOW, what a place for a home church, and it would be neat if you could get a job at the university with all the possibilities for sharing the gospel. Two weeks ago Carol and I prayed and I went to the university and asked to speak with the president and I got an interview.

I proposed to teach a class on Introduction to Aviation and Building Maintenance. They agreed to start an aviation class and gave us free housing in the midst of the student village. We moved in Thursday. Everything you need is in the student village and for the first time ever in Haiti, we have power 24 hrs. per day. We've met our neighbors and they've all been very nice to us old people. Weren't sure how they would feel about old white people moving in among them. Already talked to one young man about having a house church. He was very excited he said that after he moved out there he was disappointed to find there was no church.

We went for a walk last night all through the neighborhood. There is a huge elementary school there as well. We just pray for God to use us for His glory. Thank you so much for your prayers.

2015 EVANGELISTIC CAMPAIGN IN INDIA

We began our campaign planning last April-2014 when I was in India working with Udaya Kumer our native evangelist. We had a goal of 750 souls for Christ. He and I took no breaks and worked tirelessly and reaped 556 souls. We moved on from Kalahasty, India to Rajahmundry to work with Suman Singh and reaped 200 more souls.

2015 saw Udaya and I burning up the emails of how we are going to plan, set the plan, recruit the workers and set the course to bring to Jesus 1000 souls. We recruited the ground force to search for new villages to present Jesus the Son of God to the villagers. Ninety percent were Hindu villages never hearing about Christ.

Bags packed, ready to go, Udaya called me 3 days before I was to fly out to Chicago, IL for Chennai, India and told me NOT TO COME, at this time. He was weeping as he talked to me, knowing that we had spent a year preparing for this moment in our ministry. Bro Delroy Brown, an evangelist from Australia, was going to India at the same time with me, BUT since Udaya asked me to wait because he had been warned that the Indian police had an eye out for me, I sent Delroy to Rajahmundry to work with Suman Singh. They reaped another 200 souls for Christ.

After conferring with Reggie Thomas, and Udaya we decided I was going to proceed with caution. I boarded the plane in Chicago not knowing if I was to be turned back as soon as I landed in Chennai. Reasons—I have none. But I did know that God was in control and the Holy Spirit was going to go before us and open any doors that were blocked and guard every door that was open. The Holy Spirit was our leader in getting me through the complex of immigration.

Yes I had a VISA from the Indian government that gave me permission to come and explore their country. BUT...at the immigration desk they detained me for over 10 minutes at 2:00 in the morning when others past right through. They kept reading the screen in front of them and said not a word. After that I was gone into the night. I had the same trouble when I was to leave INDIA. Another 10 minutes of waiting and then let me board the plane for USA.

It was the Holy Spirit that I trusted to get us through the rough spots and the Spirit did just that.

Udaya and I began immediately after picking me up at the airport. I arrived at our hotel at 4 or 5 and ate breakfast at 10 and off we went to our first village. I knew that if we had a goal of 1000 souls and we had 11 days to do it in, that meant we had to have at least 100 baptisms per day. How many villages would it take to get that done? As many as it takes! I asked for 4-5 preaching spots every day and that got done.

I was asked to dedicate a new church building that White Fields had funded to be built. It was on my 71st birthday as well. What a great celebration we had together as a church family. Singing, laughing, tears of joy and excitement in a tiny village that has NO water well. There people are poor in our standards but very much happy.

Our taxi carried as much as 9 men who went from village to village rounding up interested folks to hear the gospel of Christ. They went through each village telling people that The Gospel of Jesus Christ was here to be heard. The people would gather to the appointed spot in the middle of the village

I told them thanks for inviting me to their village, I was just a simple Bible story teller and I had come to tell them a Jesus story that would change their life and their village for the rest of their life.

Every single invitation was answered to follow Jesus. They were baptized the very day or the next day, given Bibles in their language, introduced them to their regular preacher who would be back each week to teach them more of Jesus.

Each village took at least an hour of preaching. Then the villagers lined up in front of me spontaneously to have me pray for them. Each one I held close to my body with my hands on their heads and I prayed for each. They did not know my language, Udaya was doing other parts of the ministry as I prayed. Many people bent down to touch my feet as tears rolled down their faces. Lord I am not worthy of this, but day after day it was the same. There was a purpose for me going to India



We had set up a day just with the preachers. Close to 30. To come in to a church building and take off the ministerial coat and lets all be brothers. Whatever was said in the building was to remain there. I wanted them to feel equal to ask what posing questions they had on their mind and they did. All day we were brothers. Paul tells us to encourage each other and I wanted to make sure that got done.

We had several who had not been ordained into the ministry and that is now being taken care of. Everyone was filled to the brim with India's favorite food---RICE.



In all we had 1081 responses to the Gospel in our area and Delroy had 200 in his area totaling 1281 in 11 days. Lincoln Christian University this week let it be known that they had an enrollment of just over 1000, meaning that the Holy Spirit directed us to witness and reap the souls of an equal number of people in 11 days for Christ

I have so many stories and pictures but many will live on in my mind and heart forever. What does God have next? What doors need to be opened for the Gospel?

"The Shadow Of Death" by Dr. W. Blythe Robinson



This phrase is taken from **Psa. 23:4**: *"though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil for You are with me."* Notice that the shadow of death fills the valley. Have you ever thought about what it would be like to live in such dreadful place? I know what it is to *"walk through the valley,"* but not to live there. The truth is that there are those, both in and out of America, who are currently plotting to plunge us into this valley. This valley can be found in Pakistan and many other Muslim dominated countries around the world.

With Pakistan's Blasphemy Law comes a license to steal, burn, destroy or kill - without evidence or a trial. Muslims have demanded protection money from churches or else they would be attacked. Churches have struggled among themselves for no one to yield or it will be worse for all of them. A simple accusation of blasphemy is all that's required and it can come from children.

During one trip I learned of two young non-Muslim boys who were playing a game with two Muslim boys. Non-Muslims are referred to as "Christians." A dispute over the rules occurred, and a fight between them followed. The Muslim boys went to the police and reported that the "Christian" boys had violated their Blasphemy Law. They were arrested and put in jail. Simply on the word of Muslim boys they were murdered in prison that night, proving that the word of non-Muslims has no value. The next day the parents were informed. When they came for their bodies they were given some money, presumably for burial. Here "government backed religion" is a justified killer. This is real life in the valley of the shadow of death with only a 2% "Christian" population. I almost suffered the same fate last year, when our team had to run for our lives based on the "rumor of Blasphemy." This year a bus load of villagers were attacked in route to one of our Evangelistic meetings. Since returning home two churches have been bombed, very near where I stayed.

Muslim law is harsh for women. I met women who work for Muslim men who rape them and this is tolerated in order to maintain employment. Acid throwing is frequently used as a weapon in Pakistan to punish women for acts that allegedly bring dishonor to the family, for denying sexual advances by men, for attempting to obtain an education, or just to enact revenge. Although this crime is common in Pakistan, many are not reported because victims are pressured by their community to keep quiet.



"The Shadow Of Death" by Dr. W. Blythe Robinson

The following event occurred near where I was staying. Shama Bibi, 24, and mother of four, was four months pregnant when she was killed alongside her husband Sajjad Maseeh, 27, for alleged blasphemy. Over 1,500 people gathered from nearby villages after being worked up by local clerics using loudspeakers. The couple was told to convert to Islam or face death. They had no intention of converting. The only thing to do was to run for their lives in the valley of the shadow of death. Their murder was based on the fact that her father, who died, was a local religious healer. When she cleaned up his room it was reported that the next day when the garbage collector collected the trash he reported to local cleric that he had collected pages of the Koran thrown in front of Shehzad's house from the trash. The couple had been unaware that the Koran was inside a discarded package.



A mob formed, dragged them about 20 yards, and started beating the couple with sticks and bricks chanting slogans of *"We will lay down our lives for the honour of the prophet"* and then tore off their clothes. The mob broke their legs so they could not flee. Witnesses of the horrific attack reported that Shama was wrapped in cotton so she would burn faster. They were picked up by their arms and legs and held over the brick furnace until their clothes caught fire and then they were thrown inside the furnace. Their bones are still being found. Friends keep collecting them in batches of two or three. Although they will not all be found, they will be buried when they have enough to form bodies.



For a long time I have wanted to be able to do something about these dreadful conditions. I attempted this on a previous trip at a local "Peace Conference." This was advertised in the paper and many came from a great distance. Armed guards were to pick me up afterwards, but this was cancelled. Instead were walked back alone among the crowd in the dim light of the night. Later I learned that a contract had been put out on me. However a new invitation of a different nature and magnitude was offered to me and I accepted without realizing what unbelievable opportunities lay ahead. I want to share those with you in my next report because it is too lengthy for this one.
