Lindsey Herndon was one of the most wonderful friends God has ever given me. Throughout my lifetime I have always loved and admired Lindsey because he was always busy seeking lost souls that could be won to Christ. He was an Evangelist famous for starting new churches. He was a promoter of World Missions. He was an active Evangelist in world missions.

Lindsey preached the Gospel faithfully his entire lifetime. He ministered to churches in Georgia, Alabama, and Tennessee. For several years in the 1980's he was the Superintendent of the Kiamichi Mountain Christian Mission. He was also the Director of the world famous Kiamichi Clinic during those years.

Lindsey was a very active participant in the White Fields Overseas Evangelism mission. When Russia opened to the Gospel in 1991, Lindsey was one of the first Evangelists along with his brother Charles who volunteered to go with us to preach the Gospel and start churches in Russia. Lindsey traveled with us to Haiti, To India, To Russia etc. preaching and winning souls to Jesus.

Lindsey was the personal supporter of 4 Indian Evangelists. We have no one to take his place and support these 4 faithful Indian preachers. WHO WILL TAKE HIS PLACE?

I will greatly miss my friend and partner in the ministry LINDSEY HERNDON. I am so thankful that he "fought the good fight, finished the race, and kept the faith" II Timothy 4:7.,

Blessings In Haiti 34 Souls Baptized



Many years ago in 1978 the MAPOU CHRISTIAN ORPHANAGE WAS BORN in the village of Mapou (through a tragedy the orphanage had to be moved to Gonaives and the name was changed in 1995 to JESUS LOVES ME HOME) One of the first orphans who came under our care was a little boy named Francius Joseph. Esther fell in love with all the orphans, but one of her "favorites" was Francius. He always followed Esther around with a paint brush and told everybody he was "Esther's helper." When Francius Joseph grew up he declared he wanted to be a Preacher of the Gospel. We were delighted. We sent him to Port au Prince Christian College and 4 years later he graduated with honors. We were privileged to attend his graduation and Reggie was privileged to participate in his graduation.

At that time the minister of the Raboteau Church in Gonaives was growing old and feeble and so we sent Francius to Gonaives to be the Youth Minister and to study under the wise leadership of the soon to be retired minister. In a few years Francius became the Minister of the Christian Church in Raboteau and has served there faithfully ever since.

Reggie had started the Raboteau Christian Church in 1973 and his brother Edwin built the first church building the next year. After 20 years. in 1994, a group of men from Villa Heights Christian Church in Joplin replaced the roof.

TEAM NUMBER ONE

Again in 20 more years, January 24 to Feb. 2, 2015, a team of 9 workers under the direction of Lem Palmer from Kentucky have just completed a major restoration and enlargement of the Raboteau Christian church including a new roof, the walls plastered and painted etc. It is really beautiful thanks to the dedicated labors of this group of men.

At the same time the builders were doing the carpentry work, a group of women in the team held a daily vacation bible school for the over 300 little boys and girls who are student's at the Christian School held in the Roboten Church building. And at this same time Larry Jamison, who helped Reggie's brother to build the first building of the Roboten Church, and now minister from Kentucky where Lem Palmer is Elder, preached a revival meeting.

TEAM NUMBER TWO

During these same dates a large team of 19 workers led by John Hendrix were working on two more building projects. First they dug the footers and poured the concrete foundation for the Youth Center of the Christian Church of Gonaives ministered to by Sincere John the Baptiste.

Secondly they completed building the church building for the Sonshine Christian Church ministered to by Melio.

PROJECT THREE PREACHING THE GOSPEL

The Bible tell us that " It pleased God by the preaching of the Gospel to save those who believe.." The same period of time Jan. 24-Feb. 2, 2015 a team of four Preachers, Leslie Wilkerson, from North Carolina, Larry Jamison from Kentucky, along with Zane Darnell, and Reggie Thomas both of Joplin, Mo. Held simultaneous revivals for four of the Christian Churches of Gonaives. These four revivals resulted in 34 souls who accepted Christ and were buried in baptism for the remission of sins. Open Heart Surgery by Dr. Blythe Robinson



Because of my childhood, feeding the hungry was a very personal emotional experience of great depth. I know what it's like to go hungry, to go from door to door and beg for food, and to have eaten out of a garbage can. Most of all it broke my heart to hear my mother crying and saying, "I have nothing to feed you children today." I'm sure that the mothers of Pakistan have done the same. I was able by God's grace to do unto others as I had wished someone could have done unto me. I was blessed in a manner difficult to describe. There is a world of difference between seeing pictures of the hungry and seeing their actual faces wrinkled and at times tear-stained. These are some of the issues involved in a previous White Fields article titled "Burdens of the Heart." The people of Pakistan are God's "Burdens of the Heart," are they yours?



Open Heart Surgery by Dr. Blythe Robinson

In Acts 16:14 a woman named Lydia had "open heart surgery" performed by the Lord. The scripture says *"the Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul"* [NKJV]. How this was accomplished is not revealed. However, I have seen the same thing occur on my recent trip to Pakistan. It was based on an experience that I had previously in Malaysia. There, for the first time in my life, I met "Christians" who converted to Islam. I was determined to understand how this could occur. It turned out to be rather simple. The Muslims met their physical needs. This means of showing love *"opened their hearts to heed the things spoken by"* the Muslims. This is not something new.



Jesus' teachings in Mt.24:35-40 would result in achieving the same. He said *"I was hungry and you fed Me"* [V.35]. Their reply was 'when did we ever see you like this? [V.37] and when did we do this?' His answer was based on the concept that the good which we do to others *"in His name"* honors Him and will be rewarded even if we give only a cup of cold water [Mt.10:44]. Paul encouraged similar acts in Gal.6:10.

A wonderful Christian organization, identified as IDES, donated funds for us to prepare 240 food packages to feed flood victims in Pakistan. This was done explicitly in Jesus' name. Those who refused to accept the food *in His name* did not receive a package because limited funds limited our distribution. Feeding the bread of life, both physically and spiritually, *opened their hearts to hear the things that* I spoke in many places. This resulted in the message of Christ's love being spread far and wide in Pakistan, a Muslim country, where the murder of the innocent was occurring at the same time. This feeding contributed greatly to the 141 who became Christians. Our efforts planted seeds to blossom and be harvested next trip.

Attaching labels, packing the boxes, and loading them for distribution was a time consuming process.

Recently a number of emergencies had arisen at the orphanage sponsored by White Fields and Directed by Lori and Zane Darnell.

Last month we mentioned these emergencies. Two things happened right after Christmas: 1. The pump stopped working and the well ran dry. 2. The refrigerator stopped working. All 3 of these items are on the top of the "must haves" list by the Haitian Department of Social Services.

At the time we were notified of these problems, we had money to fix either the pump and well or buy a new refrigerator. We decided the pump and well were more important and we would pray for money for the refrigerator to be provided and Division of Social Services to give us time to replace / fix the problems.

Sainsurin called me. He said a man had dug the well another 10-20 feet and found water and they had made a pump out of PCV piping. This type of pump is easier to make and fix in Haiti. I was so happy that we could check this off the list.

Right before Reggie & Zane left and before the newsletter even went in the mail, God answered our prayers and provided the money for the refrigerator. We are so thankful.

I called Clotide to tell her to go to the store and make arrangements to have the refrigerator delivered. She was so happy and thankful. To our surprise, the store delivered that day, without being paid. They said Clotide was honest and they knew she would bring the money to them. This is so nice to hear!

We are so thankful for this answered prayer! We are thankful God has given us faithful supporters to help extra in our times of need.

It is always wonderful to pull up at the Jesus Loves Me Home property and see all the smiling faces of the children there. To be able to hug and love on each of the children is a blessing. One little girl in particular was happy to see me, Christy. She came to the orphanage in June 2014 by the police. She was found on the streets after her mother was taken away for insanity. Each day I came to the orphanage Christy was there waiting on me, laughing and smiling. It is such a blessing to see children like her that come from bad situations and come to the



orphanage to heal and be nurtured.

The children were in school while we were there, so I did not get to spend very much time with the other children. The first day I was there, they stayed home from school because Social Services came out to vaccinate the children. The last day I went to the orphanage at 6:30am, when they were getting ready to leave for school.

I was able to preach each night at Royale Christian Church where Jean Raymond Delzume is the Minister. Despite the rain every night we still averaged 40 to 50 each night. I preached a series on how Satan is always trying to get to us as Christians and how we can fight him off.

We were also able to visit Francilius Aime who is the former Minister of the Christian Church in St. Marc. Francilius' s health is very bad. He has had a stroke on his left side. His spirits seem very uplifted despite his health problems.

We give praise to God for giving all our team members safe journeys and victory in completion of the projects God gave us to do in His service.

Be in prayer for Haiti. Riots are becoming more frequent and gaining in violence. Pray especially for the Jesus Loves Me Home as orphanages seem to be targets for thieves. One orphanage in Port-au-Prince was raided during the middle of the night February 15. The thugs used their guns but no one was hurt. They also poisoned two of the guard dogs and killed them, they shot the other but he is ok. They stole money and electronics from one building on the property!
