

Reggie & Esther Report on Their Trip to Kentucky 5 Souls Baptized

My wife Esther, and myself, have been gone the past two weeks while I was preaching in Kentucky. First we attended a SENIORS RETREAT at White Mills, Ky.. There were seniors from 80 different Christian Churches in Kentucky. It was a very inspiring gathering. I preached twice at this retreat. The chairman of this retreat had instructed me to preach to the seniors concerning the great opportunity that is afforded them to go overseas as "short term missionaries" and their opportunity to be involved in soul winning at home. Next we went to the South Louisville Christian Church in Louisville where they were celebrating their 114th anniversary. I once preached a two weeks homecoming revival there 60 years ago and so they called me back after all these years. We were welcomed by some who remembered the revival meetings 60 years ago!!!!!! This was a very thrilling day and I preached the two morning worship services. Afterwards the church sponsored a luncheon and Esther and I were their special guests.

Next we went to Oakland, Ky. Where I preached a 4 night revival meeting for the members of the First Christian Church .. There were 5 elderly men and women who accepted Christ and were baptized. Last we returned to the White Mills Campground where the Preachers of Kentucky held a retreat. I preached three more sermons there. We were greatly blessed throughout this inspiring trip.

We got home late Saturday night after driving some 1100 miles, grateful to God for a safe journey.

Hurricane Matthew Disaster in Haiti



Thank you to everyone for praying for Haiti. There has been an outpouring of love and support sent to Haiti from other nations helping their immediate needs of water and food.

We, ourselves, understand natural disasters, but it was not until our Joplin tornado in 2011 that we fully comprehended the true impact, magnitude, and effects of a natural disaster. We have become more sensitive to the immediate needs and the long term needs.

Because of this and seeing that many, many people around the world are meeting the immediate needs in Haiti, plus our own Christian Church preachers that were not affected have already gone to take food and water to the affected areas, White Fields has decided to focus on the long term needs in Haiti.

In our last e-letter we told you of the damage that affects our Christian Church team members in Haiti. The total cost is an overwhelming \$85,000. Many have asked for the cost of individual projects. The breakdown is: \$9000 for each of the 6 destroyed church buildings, \$8500 for a 4 room house, and \$5625 for each of the 2 room houses.



As of today we have received \$4,800. We have also asked IDES for help. We are far from our goal but praying God will provide the rest. We understand that these are difficult times, but if you, your friends, or your church would like to take on one of these projects or help with one, please contact us.

Beloved Brother Reggie and Sister Esther: May the richest blessings from the Lord be upon you and your loved ones. That is the wish and prayer of my husband and myself.

Thank you so much for the prompt answer to my email, and also I am just reading now your news regarding Haiti, and as I am writing this I am praying to the Lord for those brothers and sisters who have lost family members. I am asking the Lord for His loving arms around them.



My purpose of coming to internet office was to give you a little report of my more than two months at Benin, Knowing of your love for that country, In one of the photos you see me, doing the dedication prayer to Our Father in heaven, asking His blessing of that place,

I was received with much love in all the churches that I visited, and my heart was overjoyed to see many little churches that were started after my last visit three years ago, We had beautiful prayer meetings in Bohicom Church for a full week three times a day and almost every service the church building full of sisters and brothers.

With offering given by brothers and sisters, I was able to buy an electronic piano Yamaha for them that it will be used in the churches of Abomey and Bohicom. Also I took 200 cups for communion for the new churches, and most of my luggage was towels, clothing for men and women, medication that was given to me by a friend doctor, some toys for children. Also by the Lord's Grace I was able to purchase 24 Bibles in Fon language, to give them to preachers and collaborators in the churches, the Bible in Fon language was completed and put to sale only about year and a half ago, and the brethren were very thankful.

Beloved Brother Reggie and Sister Esther, I am praying now to the Lord that He will give me the opportunity some time next year to go to Haiti, to learn from the brethren there about working and caring



for the orphanages and how to be efficient in the administration of such a home. I had many years ago the blessing to visit Geon orphanage in Seoul, Korea and I marveled how well it was conducted, and I feel that I need to learn even more, because our Lord's work should be done in a way to honor His Name then the unbelievers will give praise to Him only.

Report From Rick & Della Deighton



By the time you receive this letter, Rick may be leaving Ukraine and going to Germany for the last leg of this mission trip. I told him I would do the prayer letter this time, and it may not be at all like he does it, but I hope you will enjoy reading it anyway. And you can look forward to next month when he is back and can share his experiences with you. I asked Sam Hough if he would write something for me concerning the time he spent in Ukraine working with Rick. Below is what he wrote. - Della

"This September I had an opportunity to travel to the Ukraine with Rick Deighton from Overseas Outreach. I had a great time preaching and teaching with Rick in 3 major cities and in one smaller town in central Ukraine. Together we shared the gospel of Christ at churches, orphanages, synagogues, coffee shops, and a university.

The first bulk of our time together we spent about a week with Love Cradle Ministries in Mala Viska, reaching out to State-run orphanages. Every day we loaded up a trailer with humanitarian aid supplies, which we delivered to different orphanages. Sometimes that included fresh produce, blankets, pillows, sheets, shoes, jackets, cloths, and other supplies. When we arrived at each orphanage, we were met either by the state appointed directors or their assistant directors. After meeting we were given an opportunity to speak with a group of the children.

Rick always spoke first with them about world view and the importance of having a world view with Christ at the center. Afterwards, I spoke with them about the love and power of God. I always began my message with a statement, 'You are deeply loved.' One orphan boy shouted from the back, 'By who?' and then I had the opportunity to share the truth that no matter what happens in our lives, no matter who might abandon us or hurt us in this world, God loves us and wants to be with us and give us a new kind of life.

We then took a train from Mala Viska to Odessa, where we spent most of the rest of our time together teaching students at Open Christian University. Together we were guest teachers in the 1st - 4th year English classes. Each day we taught 4 classes. Rick taught 2, and I took 2. Rick's focus in his teaching was sharing the importance of having a Christian world view and understanding a creation origin. I focused my lessons on stories from the Bible that teach us that God knows us, loves us, cares about us, calls us, and sends us. As I taught stories from the Bible, I also shared evidences from a creation science perspective.

After classes we almost always had a church to visit, a missionary to connect with, or an outing of some sort. I especially enjoyed my time getting to know many of the students and touring the city with them. They invited me to a Bible study prayer group that I really enjoyed. I also really enjoyed getting to know some of the missionaries and visiting some Messianic Jewish worship services.

The last stop for my part of the trip was in Kharkov where we visited with Zhenya Molodchy. We visited with a Messianic church on Saturday, and Sunday we had the opportunity to visit with the church that Zhenya is starting. It was good to get to know him and his family. Then I had to leave Rick in Ukraine and fly home. It's been over a week since I have been home, and I'm still trying to regain my energy.

It was a great trip. If I had to do it again, I would spend a bit more time working on learning some Russian language. This Sunday I will be sharing about my trip with the church after our worship services. I had a great time with Rick. He is a good man with a great heart for the Lord. I will keep him in my prayers as he continues his time in eastern Europe and Germany."
