

The children at Pignon have been living in a rented house since last May. Brother Tooger Smith and his wife Chief had a vision of starting an orphanage in a



need place in Haiti. They requested Reggie to find a place and they would pay all expenses. Reggie found the place and so far 10 needy boys have found a home at Mark's House. The home is name in honor of Tooger and Chief's handicapped son Mark.

The Great Commission Inside Out

N.T. Christians are marked by their insistence that we must have Book, Chapter, and Verse for all that is taught and practiced. Therefore we must take seriously the commandment from the Lord Himself in Mt.28:18-20 to go into the entire world and win the lost. However reality forces me to ask: which is greater among us, the *Preaching* of this message or the *Practice* of it?

After attending a multitude of church services and hearing endless radio sermons, I have yet to hear, one sermon devoted *entirely* to this commandment. Of all the commandments given by our Lord, there is none with more emphasis on its *Authority* than this one!! It is found in these words: "*All Authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Therefore GO (Greek) into all the nations and make them My disciples.*" Mk.16:15 clarified how, saying: "*preach the Gospel to everyone.*" Do we?

Only a few have attempted to restrict "The Great Commission" to the Apostles. Instead we often appear to have replaced the Apostles' responsibility with the "Preacher." Therefore if the lost are to be saved we are to bring them to church and let the preacher do it. Our practice implies that only the preacher is authorized to do what Jesus commanded the Apostles to do. How they did this is seen in Acts 2:42 with 8:1, 4. This seems to be either unknown or misunderstood. Have you heard these verses taught where you attend? If not, would you be willing to share these verses with others?

What would you do if I could tell you of a way to win the lost "Inside" America that would also win the lost "Outside" of America? The answer is simple but its practice requires patience over time. The first step is to recognize the complexity for all of us to leave America and travel to some distant foreign country. Let's be honest, the world "Outside" of America is today a very dangerous place; we aren't even safe from attack "Inside" America. Add to this the required vaccinations and the expense of flying.



The Great Commission Inside Out

How many can leave jobs and family to make such trips? How many feel confident enough to publicly give a message to individuals and groups? Giving money to missions is no substitute for failing to spread the word "Inside" America to *all the nations of the world that are already here* but they don't hear from us. We are failing our calling!



We can begin by showing interest in them. Then keep going back and working to build a relationship. You will meet them in all kinds of places from parks to small business, or as hotel operators, etc. Sometimes young people can meet them in schools and build a relationship that can lead to contact with their parents. We can offer prayer for their needs; we can ask questions about their country and its religion. Even if we feel awkward, they will see that we are trying. This all takes patience, practice and prayer.

The church needs to do more training of the membership in personal evangelism. None of this will ever happen if Christianity is merely a passive Sunday event that is simply a religious "pep rally." All those converted "Inside" can help to convert their contacts "Outside" of America and thus fulfill "the Great Commission" as demonstrated below.

Recently Becky and I met in Atlanta with a man from a foreign country where I had ministered often. He in turn introduced me to another man from a different country which then introduced me to a third man from a different part of the world. I ended up preaching to three groups from the following language areas using three different translators: *Burmese, Chin, and Mizo*. It took two days, but the seeds are now being widely planted.

I am in the process of establishing Daystar Bible Institutes in their parts of the world. This demonstrates how "The Great Commission works "Inside-Out". I Cor.15:58
