I have heard many reports coming out of India. Reports of the government cracking down on Christian preachers who come to India to preach the Gospel. Reports of Nationalist Hindus capturing our Christian preachers, beating them, setting them on fire and leaving them in the town square for all to see. Reports of young girls being set on fire because of their Christian morals and beliefs. It is the Holy Spirits job to bust down the doors of oppression, bondage, and unsilenced those who are scared to preach the Gospel of Christ. I hear these reports and at the same time I have reports from Chennai, and Rajahmundry who are crying for preachers to come and preach. My calling is to preach and let the Holy Spirit take care of the rest.

This year I had a little slow down in leaving the United States. It was one year ago that age 73 I underwent open heart surgery for a triple bypass. Sandy, my wife was having some medical issues in January and I could not leave until I knew she was in good health. I went with her to her doctors appointment and went through a list of items and then said to the Doctor that I could not leave the United States with her not in perfect health. He laughed at me and told

me to she was in great hands health wise and for me not to worry. The next day I made the reservations to head to India. I was not going to worry or fret what was going on in India except preparations for a great evangelistic endeav-

With a Hindu President and an attitude to chase all evangelistic churches, preachers, schools, we made it a real concern to be safe, stay safe, and have lots of prayer being offered on behalf of this 9th trip. Each time I go, I start early in the preparations. There are several native preachers who want me or someone like me to come to their aid in a section of India.

As an Evangelist, I know that I have to raise the money it takes to go, transportation, lodging for 3 weeks, meals for everyone, stipend salary for the Pastors, 700 Bibles in their own language, buying clothes for ladies, men, children, helping with the 3 orphanages, and many of the incidental expenses

I figure if God wants me to go He will make the way clear. I have been fortunate these 9 times to have Gods hand on me for protection and making the way smooth and paid for even before I leave. Amen

Two Locations

This year I went to two locations---Rajahmundry, a city on the coast line and Chennai—also known as Madras. Suman Singh and Isaac Dhaz spear head our ground evangelism coverage. I correspond months in advance to make sure the dates, supplies, needed gifts, budgets are being planned. I pray with them and their families and I ask the same for my family. I always promote the New Testament plan of salvation and stress the need to follow those guidelines. I do not want to be thousands of miles away and have a problem with the dialog of How to become a Christian, etc. I tell them that when I come, I do not come for a vacation I come to win souls for Christ and to help them build not only their church but the new ones we will start together. I have never ever had a problem with that. The wisdom of the Holy Spirit prevails without any difficulty. I tell them that I



can rest back in my Indiana home when I return. We schedule 4 to 5 preaching times per day and move on to the next village.

They buy the Bibles in the native language at a cost of \$3.50 each. They buy Sari's for the women who need to be clothed and buy lap cloths for the men as well as the equipment for schools, books, food, teachers, medicine, paper, pens,

etc. You could give each of these men \$200 a month and that would take the monkey off of their backs, and each of the strain for supplies for paper, books, food, and lodging, for the students. I need help for them and they need American Christian help if we are to sustain the growth Reggie Thomas began many years ago.
