# Challenges and Victories in Liberia By Barry Kermeeen

I arrived in Liberia on Nov. 3rd. It was my sixth trip to that West African nation. I was glad to be met at the airport by Aaron Whisnant. He leads the Triumph church. Aaron was the first evangelist that I worked with in Liberia twelve years ago.

The Liberians voted for a new president on Oct. 10th. The candidate that got the most votes didn't get the required 51% needed to win. Two other candidates filed an appeal to challenge the results. I had asked people to pray that the capital city of Monrovia would be peaceful while I was there. Prayers were answered. It was. It reminded me of being in Monrovia twelve years ago during the week of their election. There was unrest



that week because the supporters of the losing candidate were upset about the results. By the end of the week, the Liberians that we worked with told us that we shouldn't go out to preach on Friday evening. They wanted us to stay inside at the hotel. During the week, there were two different times when Aaron took me to the hotel on his motorbike, so I wouldn't be stuck in traffic. On this trip, I didn't want our plans to change because of unrest in the city. We were able to stick with our schedule. The Liberians are still waiting to see what the outcome of the election will be!

On the evening of Nov. 4th, I started preaching outside in Virginia. Patrick Lewis is the evangelist with the church there. I also worked with him in 2005. A few minutes after I started to preach, it began to rain. We moved into the building, but the rain was so loud hitting the metal roof, I told the men that I wouldn't try to preach over all the noise. The next day was the Lord's day. I got to teach on personal evangelism that morning. We were back there in the evening to preach the word outside again.

Three women wanted to obey the gospel, after hearing about the beginning of the church, in a message from the second chapter of Acts. We thanked God for their decisions! We had a portable “baptistry” at each location where we preached. It was made out of three rows of concrete blocks which were laid in a rectangle. A tarp was put inside to hold the water, which was carried from wells. It was a good idea! I hadn’t seen that done on previous trips. We preached there the next evening, before moving to the next location.

On Nov. 7th, I started preaching outside next to the building that the New Life Victory church meets in. Christopher Smith is the evangelist with the church. After the gospel was preached, six souls wanted to obey it! Two more were added by the Lord, after obeying it on the next night. After every decision, we rejoiced and thanked God for the power of the gospel! (Luke 15:10, Romans 1:16) On Nov. 9th, the annual church of Christ convention started in the morning. It was nice. I had never been to one. The theme that was chosen was Preserving The Doctrine Of The Church Of Christ. Aaron asked me to speak on The Essence Of Water Baptism. Some of the other topics were The Lord’s Supper, Marriage, and Personal Evangelism. There was time for questions after each of us finished speaking. Three more souls obeyed the gospel on the night of Nov. 9th. The Lord continued to bless our efforts!

On Nov. 10th, I preached on Faith Island. What a place! I had never been there before. We walked about a half a mile to get there. It was a nice walk. There was a foot bridge that was probably over a hundred yards long, that we crossed. We were set up on a football (soccer) field. It was beautiful back there! There were probably about 200 people present that night. Two women wanted to be baptized into Christ. They were in Christ before they left that night! (Romans 6:3, Galatians 3:27) On the last night of preaching outside on Faith Island, nine souls were immersed into Christ for the forgiveness of sins! What a night! The Lord blessed us, and answered prayers.

With the help of you and IDES we raised about \$30,000 to help St Martin. Hurricane Irma took the roof off part of the church, destroyed the church van, and did damage (slight to severe) to the church members homes. The first repairs are being made. I will report to you as soon as I get reports.

The biggest change for White Fields was Reggie's retirement. I happily stepped into his place. Transitions have been smooth.
