Good News From Justin Avery in Cuba



I recently returned from my trip to Havana, Cuba. The purpose of this trip was to teach at the Cuba Bible Institute. I spent the week with 30 pastors from all different areas of Cuba opening up the Word and encouraging one another with it's truth. This was an incredible experience and blessing for me and I hope for them as well.

We spent the week working through the Old Testament. From 9am to 4pm each day I taught Old Testament Survey in a very warm room. I don't think most people in my Sunday School class in the states would have stayed awake for 10 minutes but these pastors stayed engaged and hungry for more til the very end of the week. They are passionate

for learning and growing in their knowledge of the scripture. It was a humbling experience to see their love for their churches expressed in this way. The Sunday before these classes started my wife Heidi and I had the privilege to worship with a house church in Havana.

Nearly everything about this church service was different from what we are accustomed to. The church meets on the front porch of Rolando and Isis's apartment. They gather around with lawn chairs in the hot and humid Caribbean morning. They greet every one who comes with a kiss and a hug and a warm smile. They sung along with a large boombox sat on a counter next to the front door but they easily outsang the recordings. Their passionate worship was a treasure to witness and be a part of.

They didn't have so many of the things we take for granted in our church and frankly on occasion argue about it in church. There were no walls to decorate, no pews to clean, no air conditioner to adjust, no lights, no screen, and not a single sleeping person in the gathering. Was this a perfect church? Of course not. I am certain they have had their trials and temptations as any congregation has during its life but there was so much we could learn in the simplicity of their gathering. When you strip away all of the stuff that can become trappings all we really need is what we experienced in that church in Havana; passionate worship, teaching of the Word, fellowship around the Lord's Supper, and a love for one another.

This month I started visiting the school. This year there are more children than last, more than 80. As usual most of them don't have parents, sometimes maybe the grandparents are guardians. The school also put me in one classroom helping and supporting aggressive children. We have 2 meetings already. 4 boys beat each other, they are filled with hate and aggression. I talked with one of the boys. His mom left him when he was young, he doesn't even know who she is. His father beats him and talks badly to him. Now the father has another woman and children. The boy feels rejected and angry, he hates everything. It's so sad because this is happened so often. But our people choose to reject God so now we earn the fruits. The girl who was sexually abused is no more in our school. She is not from our town so I don't have information what is happening. The director of the school say that they are so thankful for my work with these children, but this is really exhausting me.

This month was so stressful for me as the school start and we have some new rules for 9 grade. Rebeka is 9 grade and we have to buy very, very expensive books. And Georgi's stress of not having work. We borrow money from friends. Now Georgi is looking for a one month job abroad to earn money. I don't know what he will find but also hope this won't be our life as are many here - one of parents is working in abroad and sending money home. From all of this I start to have high blood pressure, not normal for me as all my life I'm very low. I know God will make a way where seems to be no way but we just need patience.

Also we are preparing 2 seminars. One is for internet abuse. As many children using internet and start to have many problems because of cyber bullying. For these seminars we invite children, parents, social workers, psychologues, teachers. Many of them are interested, they don't say no or call us a cult, they say Thank you. God is working.

I am happy to inform to you that we returned to the tribal area. That place is full of Hinduism as they worship stone Gods and forest Goddess. We gather some tribal people and tell them about Jesus Christ. They were interested to learn, we preach the Word of God. Some people accept some did not accept because they are in Hinduism. One person come forward and ask me please build a church in our area. The next day my co preacher and myself go and ask which place is suitable for church, the man show a place that is suitable. Immediately we go to the owner and ask for the sale price. He asked what is the purpose? I said for church purpose. He go to talk to his wife she is willing to sale the place. I give advance and pray for that place and started brick wall two steps. This place is very important, Please pray for this need. The land cost is 8 lacks in Indian money (\$11,000US),

construction cost is 5 lacks Indian money (\$6,900 US) please pray for this church building.

I am happy to inform to you I got marriage license from government of India it is great news. Our government does not issue any marriage license to Indian preachers. But our works about orphans and school children's services they conducted several enquiries. It has taken 4 years! By the Grace God and your prayers.
