We are in desperate need of a generator for the Jesus Loves Me Home. Prospere has been looking for one in the Gonaives area. They start at \$850.

It is also time to prepare for the kids to start back to school next month. We need to buy books, notebooks, uniforms, socks and shoes and supplies. They need \$3000. Please join us in prayer that we can raise these funds.

**St Thomas Orphanage**  
The St Thomas Kids are still so thankful for their new socks and shoes and writing notes of thanks.

They start school this month. They need \$1500 for their books and supplies.

**Promise Land Children**

Their next big project will be building classrooms for their school.

**Anna Enoch Orphanage**  
We thank you and all our kids donors who make our orphanage a good place for kids to be. We pray that the Lord will bless you continually. We will find it very difficult to forget what you are doing for us here in Liberia.

We write to acquaint you with the problems that the school is presently facing with seating for the kids. The armchairs are broken and we are in need of some armchairs for the kids. They are sold here for \$30.00 each, we need about 50 pieces before the school can open in September. We have planned to build a science laboratory for the school because the library and the science laboratory cannot fit in the same class. Most of the materials are delicate and so it will not be good for the children to play with them. The higher classes can best manage them better than the kids who will go to read and study for the assignments. Please pray with us. A plan will be sent to you soon for you to see. I am keeping the laboratory equipment here. They will be put in as soon as the building is built.

We are also planning to build a playroom and a study hall for the kids in the mission. It can be hard for them to play when the rains fall. They get muddy and enter the house with the mud which can be very difficult for us. They need to play and study.

We have begun the painting of the dorms beginning with girls dorm for the 172nd Independence Day Celebrations.

India

I am requesting you please pray for this young couple. We counseled many times but due to so many reasons both families not listened and they separated. Eldest son have one daughter and second son have a boy. I am requesting you please pray for their families.

In my family, my mother-in-law Dhanamma's health is not well. She is suffering with weak nerves, goiter in her neck, anxiety, and arthritis problems. I took her to a specialty hospital. They did blood test, urine test and x-ray. Unfortunately the results showed that she have diabetes and low BP. After listening the news from the doctor she fainted and cried out. The doctor prescribed and gave medicine for one month. Now she is taking medicine. My wife Sujatha is taking care for her. I am requesting you please pray for her health.
