We also make a new step in the project in Onaville that we started 5 years ago, we now build the girls dorm, we already had the boys dorm built. For the year 2019 we will love to and will pray that God to helping us build the Christian school and the church in Onaville, and the church in Bellevue for the new congregation. We were in Number One Compound, Grand Bassa County where a new church has began. We had two nights of Crusade with 68 souls coming to the Lord. A service was held on Sunday to start the new church and 6 souls came to the Lord. That means 74 persons were baptized into Christ. We left Bro. Peter Zaway in charge of the church. We give God the glory for His goodness toward us.



I told you about the experiences that we had on the way to Number One Compound Grand Bassa County. We caught some hard time on the way. Before leaving the city a day before the fan blades broke to pieces. I replaced it. On our way, the engine lost power and the bus could not go any further. We sent for the Mechanic from a distant, while we waited for him. He came and did some work on it, but it did not take us long to slow down again. We had to keep on pumping and hand pump from Paynesville to The Town we were going to. Getting closer, the front tyre bust and so we had to stop and change it. Well after 9:00 P. M. We still had a service to inform the people of our presence that night. The Town Chief gave us a place have the Crusade and a place to begin the church. He also gave us a place to worship until he can fine a land for us to buy and build a church.



Thanks for all your prayers and support to us. We have planned to go to Nimba and Guinea in the coming month for two weeks to visit some of the churches including the ones in Guinea. I am sending few pictures for you to see section of the service, a Baptism and the bus loaded for us to return to Monrovia.
