Causes of low attendance: One sister pass away; 2 have dementia; 2 traveled to foreign countries; 7 don't continue with us; 10 live in other municipals far from us and can't come frequently.
Biblical Studies: Since 2007 to middle of 2017 with the congregation we read and study every verse from Genesis to Malachi and finished that year studying Revelation. In 2018 we continued with Matthew and Mark.

Prayer homes: In 12 homes we have had meetings for prayer especially those in most needs, we do this on Thursdays..

Christian wedding: We had one wedding.

There were new made appointments made in the Nimba Churches., Bro. Luke B. Enoch was taken from the Zinpa church so that he can Coordinate the church freely. He was replaced by Bro. Maxin Lormie. Old Man Henry Payne was replaced by Bro. Ojuku Lormie. He asked us to replace him since he was old. We are praying that the men will do much for the Lord In the coming new year.

Please remember our requests for lands some of our churches who have found some, But not purchased. They cannot do any work on the lands until the land are for them legally. Some of them have lands but no building. Some of them have clay blocks prepared needing cement and metal sheets to begin their projects. Keep us in prayers.

We are planning to go for our usual yearly Crusade which can bring new churches into being. There are many Macedonian calls from Nimba, Grand Bassa County, Grand Cape Mount, and Bomi Counties. We are not sure if we can reach all of them please pray with us for fuel oil, gas and food for the Team members who go with me around the Country. Some of them suspend their businesses for the Crusades. They need Prayers for their family members especially their children.

I am very much happy to share about our Chittoor Church of Christ yearly gospel work news with you all.

OUR GOAL : First, it's very difficult to gather people and make them to understand about Gospel of Christ. However, we gathered thousands of people to accept Christ as their own savior with whole heart and good news about Jesus Christ.

1. Many people from strong Hindu families are accepting Jesus Christ as their personal Savior by obeying in Baptism and living for Christ. The Gospel is preached to the unreached villages by preaching the gospel in the street (street preaching), personal evangelism, household contacts, distributing the tracts and Gospel books.

2. Every month we are conducting village crusade meeting in different villages. Last year we had more then 50 crusade meetings and nearly 9000 people were accepted Jesus Christ as their own savior. More then 2000 people took baptism.

3. Chittoor Church of Christ Children's Home was started with a great vision of serving the orphan children, tribal children, child laborers and poor children. At present 30 parent less kids are taken care of by Chittoor Church of Christ Children's Home and we're providing free food , shelter, education and medical needs. Already, more then 800 children have completed their higher studies and working in some villages and they all are blessed by our great service. Some children have become preachers and are doing gospel work around some villages in India. Every year at least 10000 children are met through VBS (Vacation Bible School). Through VBS program we teach about bible and making dramas, activities to encourage the children to know about Jesus and have them to know about, How to grow in Christ?. We're conducting more than 40 free tuition centers in different villages were many school dropped-out children are benefited. We're also provided school books, notes, school materials, etc., We're also paying their school fees for the poor children and have appointed tuition teachers to help them to study well.

4. Now 40 tuition centers with nearly 3500 children are studying and being benefited. Children of illiterate parents as well as parents who are unable to help their children in studies leave their children in these centers. The teachers are given a monthly stipend and they help the student to complete their school home work and score more in the exams and have a bright future.

5. Frequent medical camps are conducted in the villages. The poor people avail free checkups by the authorized doctors. Awareness programs for HIV/AIDS, Cancer, malarial infection and other communicable diseases are conducted. Education on nutrition is also conducted for pregnant women, feeding mothers, young girls and children.

Through this project thousands people could get the benefits and could see the love of Christ. We're taking care of 30 widows and old aged people. Our vision is to give New life to them and provide all necessary needs and make them strong in Christian faith. We supported more than 800 families, those who all are affected by the recent flood in Kerala by providing housing commodities, like rice, medicines, food, clothes water and provision for daily use for the rehabilitation for the above affected people.

Thanks a lot for your big heart support for Chittoor Church of Christ which is committed to the evangelism and discipleship of the people and winning more souls.. With your support, we have been able to move forward with this commitment. God will surely bless you abundantly for all the support that you are providing for this ministry works in India in the year 2018. It is really a blessing for me to be a part of this ministry. What can I say about my ministry in Haiti during 2018? It has been a wonderful year with some ups and downs. But, because God is never fail, He always has a way out for His children. I could say, yes God is great.

With First Christian Church, God has been really good to us. We grow spiritually and also in quantity as well. We started meeting with about 40 people during 2018, but now we are meeting with 80 and plus people at times. It is exciting to see how God is working. I used to be the one teaching Sunday classes, but we were able during the year to divide the classes as I trained some monitors to be able to teach, so thanks to God we have over 8 teachers to teach the classes under my supervision of course. During the year of 2018, we were able to start a micro credit for the church members, but as we didn't have much to give away, we were able to give to only 5 members which doesn't represent much as the church has a lot of needs. We collect less than a \$1.50 us in a Sunday service. The parents don't have much. We have many kids that don't go to school, my family help just two as they are a lot....so we started a craft project just so we can help the church as it's growing in members, we don't have a way yet to sell what we have, I believe this would be a big opportunity to help the church take care of its members as the mission of the church is not only to fish people and equip them for Jesus, but as Jesus saw human in the whole when He was on the earth until now, so the church must see people in the whole picture as Jesus' immediate representative on earth.

Apart from that, we are so glad that the White Fields friends were able to help us make a lot at the church like finishing the pulpit, by putting tiles and finishing the ceiling as well, but now we have the floor that needs tiles. They were able to provide some instruments for our worship, but because they are not complete we have to rent and borrow each time we have an activity like this week we had a revival, we had to borrow a few as we couldn't afford renting like we did at the harvest celebration of the church in Aprilwe have the in front of the church that needs a little porch to help with the rain, because when it rains, water goes through the front windows....Edwin Thomas suggested that idea, but we didn't follow up with it...we haven't finished the painting yet....the year of 2018 has been great with some great accomplishment as you could see while reading through, but we have a lot to accomplish in 2019 such as: finishing the floor, completing the worship instruments, being able to sell our craft project work to help some kids to go to school, a scholarship program would be a big opportunity for the church, putting up the porch, painting.... These are some goals to be achieved in 2019.

At Mark's House, what could I say? It was a great year for us as well. The boys were able to make it to the next level in their school, no one repeated class, they all did great. They were able to grow as well in gaining some more understanding from God's words. And because of that they serve each other better and being more obedient to Nadine and I as their immediate parents. The support is always come on time to help provide for their needs. God has been great to us in providing for us and provided for those that are providing for us. We are grateful that God provided well with electrical pump for us to have water which is something really difficult in Haiti. God provided through great friends a stable electricity system, so now we are out of electricity only when the sun doesn't show up, after that we always have electricity. It used to be a challenged for us to sleep because of the warmed temperature, but now because of the electricity system we sleep better now. We were able to stop buying ice constantly in town and continue to buy vegetables and meat, but now with our stable electricity we are able to conserve our vegetables and meet and find cold water to drink... Rats was causing us a lot of trouble, but since we have had in place a beautiful ceiling, it is good now. I can say that through our faithful supporters God has provided a lot of great opportunity in 2018.

So now, we have some goals for 2019 as well; about things that we would like to ameliorate like the boys are too many in that single room, even if I saw the need of that, but that was the first thing IBSR crew told me when they stopped by in October. Tiles as well the for the floors in the rooms and also in the showers and toilets. As Tooger suggested to have twelve disciples like adding two more boys, but because all the ten now are living in a little single room, it makes that plan difficult to occur, so this is our hope to change that in 2019 and being able to add the two more boys even before the academic school year start. The boys wouldn't be in good shape without helpers to cook for them to clean for them and so on...God has provided amazing helpers to help at Mark's Home.



For my family, I can say God has been too good to my family. He answered one of my two 2018 goals the first one was to have a son and the second was to make a visit to the States, and I think God answered both, because the second didn't happen, cause I didn't have time to go ask for a visa, so it is going to happen in 2019. God has blessed us and our friends with good health even if we had some health difficulties at times, but God always had it under control. So To Him be the glory.

But despites of the good things that has been happening in my family, we do have some challenges that we long to overcome and live a bit better in 2019. Our living condition in a single room has been a real challenge for us in 2018, it is where we put all our staff, it is where we sleep... so you can imagine how difficult it is when our son born in that condition, it was a real challenge for two, so you can imagine what it is for three...so with that said my family and I need a better place to sleep in taking care of the boys in 2019...

About Kids Club Pignon, everything is going well. Kids Club has founded in 2014 in the objective to help teaching the kids that their parents don't have time to teach them God's words. We meet once a week to study the Bible and have some fun time together. It has been a wonderful ministry to the community of Pignon as it is the only permanent teaching center for Kids. We have achieved a lot of great things in the past years, but many of our goals have stayed pending...like being able to assist our kiddos during the academic school year with school supplies, provide a meal for them even once a month or every two months...Being able to help them celebrate Christmas better as KCP is the only Santa Claus they have that can make them happy with some toys during Christmas season...and also help a few with their school tuition as some of their parents cannot afford paying school for them. Our hope is that during 2019 God will help us to generate some projects that can provide money and then we can be more present in the lives of our precious kiddos, by the way a snack is provided in each of our gathering, so Kids Club is a great ministry as I believe it is the foundation of the society, so please help me minister to those kiddos so that God's kingdom can continue to grow.



To our faithful friends thanks a lot for all you do in 2018. We have appreciated your partnership with us in sharing the gospel from the first day until now (Philippians 1:3-6), He who began a good work in us will bring it to completion.
