We also gave out 14 Bibles at the Achin Christian Church.



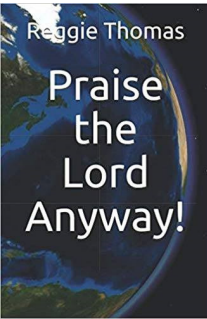

No one ever sees Haiti in the news and what is going on here. The world really doesn't care about Haiti or its people. I just heard there is a fire at the airport. I cannot confirm it yet. Roadblocks, manifestations burning, rock-throwing, and shootings... No law and order. Our Haitian friends are not doing this. It's the young thugs and those who want to take over Haiti, the opposition. When you have no jobs (85% unemployment), no money, no electricity, no running water, no hope for the future... These things happen. The poor suffer, especially the children. The city is shut down. Almost nothing is open. Haiti is in chaos, political and economic turmoil. Please pray! Haitian Customs has been closed for days. We cannot get any of our food out of Customs until it opens. This is an emergency. Haiti is in a food crisis. Any food we can find here, we will buy to help the people. The price of food has soared out of sight.

Cuba is also in crisis. Because of the Helms Burton Act, Cuba is out of fuel, they have no electricity, and barely any food. The Cuban people are suffering.

Christmas at the Jesus Loves Me Home
It is time to start planning our annual Christmas for the Jesus Loves Me Home. We want to buy all of the usual Christmas items, but we would love to have extra money to buy playground equipment. We would also like to help Mark's House and Promise Land Kids to have a nice Christmas. If you can help out with a few extra dollars over the next couple of months, you will be bringing a lot of smiles and love to some children who



need those the most.

Promise Land Kids
The Promise Land Kids have not been able to start school. They are in desperate need of funding for books, notebooks, and school fees. It costs \$300 per child for school for one year, so for 39 children it costs \$11,700 for one year. This includes uniforms, supplies, and tuition. They have the uniforms, but still need \$2340 for supplies and \$7800 for the tuition. At the moment they were given funding to build their own classrooms on their compound, they are hurrying to finish these rooms. But with all the problems in Haiti, they won't be able to have the classrooms done in time, so the children will have to go to public schools..

Anna Enoch Orphanage
The school Campus is being improved for the kids. I am about to build a basketball court for the students. By the help of the Lord, the science laboratory will begin by the end of the month. We have some concrete blocks on the ground with the steel pillars and mats. We need rocks and cement to begin the work.

We have ninety arm chairs and still need more for the students in the school because we made the school tuition free for children whose parents cannot afford to send them to schools here in Monrovia due to very high fees. This means that we have to get the P. E. uniforms and I. D. Cards for all the students since some of them are not registering. Please pray with us. We will buy reams of sheets, chalk by carton, and other materials for the school to run this year.

Mark's House
The boys at Mark's House were so excited to go back to school. Most schools in Haiti are still closed due to the demonstrations, so the boy's are blessed that Pignon stays calm and they can carry on their education.



Help Needed in Haiti

Pignon, Haiti-

Jean Ronel and the First Christian Church have 2 new outreaches.

- 1. They are teaching a literacy class. They will be using the Bible and other Christian literature as their teaching material. Pray that this will reach more people for Christ.
- 2. A lot of couples in Haiti do not get legally married because they feel they have to have rings and wedding clothes. First Christian Church would like to help with this. They would like to have a “wedding closet” so that the couple will have no excuse. They have asked that if anyone has wedding dresses, rings, suits to please donate for this outreach.

Bigot Christian Church, Gonaives, Haiti-

The Bigot Christian Church was built in 1985. At that time Bigot was in the country, now Gonaives has spread into Bigot and the area is crowded. People have squatted and built on the church property. These people are now discouraging people from attending church and they disrupt the church service. It is a MUST that we put a fence around this church before anymore damage happens. A Judge in Gonaives told us a block wall fence is our only way to stop people from squatting on the property. The total cost for a block wall fence around the property is \$8895. Please pray as this is a very urgent project.

I give God the glory for the trip to center Liberia, Gbarnga City at the Greater Refuge Church #2. At the two night revival, there were seven people who received Christ and obey in baptism.

The Church has a newly established branch at the north of Gbarnga where we should have had the two night revival but due to heavy rainfall and given the lack of good structure for worship, we couldn't have gone there. The Church is asking all donors to join them in prayer for a lot of land. A lot is sold here for \$1300 USD.

Pastor Sumo is married and bless with four children but he and his family are under serious attack from the devil; He underwent an operation at the latter part of last year where his intestines were adjusted. That spot have began to open, he now needs another medical attention. More importantly his wife is currently admitted at the JFK Hospital here Monrovia as diabetic. PST. John had to rush in town yesterday and slept at the JFK Hospital last night. He spoke to me this morning.

Please, he is a poor preacher. He needs your prayers and financial assistance very urgent! Urgent!! There is no fixed cost now but whatever the Lord lay on someone's heart to help with will be appreciated. Here, we can be told the problems our patients face and we buy the needed medicine from other areas by prescription meanwhile a night at JFK cost \$50. Very urgent. God bless you
