We the preachers, co-workers and my family members are all facing lot of trials during this pandemic situation. In this month first week my wife Sujatha got sick, she is suffering with high fever, cough and body pains. After one day myself got fever, then my daughter got fever. Then we suspected Covid-19 virus, after that we were in self quarantine.

I purchased bulk of medicine, nutrition food and provisions for one month. Now we are in self-medication through the advises of our family doctor. I am requesting you please pray for us. In India 1,435,453 positive cases confirmed and 32,771 deaths registered. In Andhra Pradesh 96,298 positive cases recorded and 1041 deaths happened. Here in India the virus has spread in communities. All government and private hospitals are filled with Covid-19 patients. Not only common people but also doctors, police, revenue, municipal, and all other government and non-government employees are affected with this virus, among many of them are dying due to their low immunity levels/major health issues. Everyone is afraid due to this deadly virus. Many churches had closed due to the Red Zones/Containment Zones.

Our preachers Baburao, David Paul, Luke Kumar, Johnson, Karunakar, John, Raja, Prabhakar, Shantavardhan, Prasad, Yesudass and co-workers Ashok, Nagamma, Kumar, Estheramma and Rajesh are suffering a lot. They are all struggling for their survival. Every day they are seeking for their daily bread/food. Due to the lockdown of churches our preachers are facing lot of financial problems and they are looking for help. I am requesting you sister please help us and pray for us. I am so thankful to each and everyone those who are sending their valuable support to my Ministry. We are also praying for you sister for your kind and generous heart.
