Since our instruments at the Triumph Church got stolen, we don't have any to use during services. I'm kindly asking the saints of God to help us purchased these instruments (\$950usd ). They are very important in taking the gospel in our country. We really need them!!

We will resume our regular soul winning campaign once all the rain has stopped. We are trusting God for mini bus (\$9000) for transportation. This helps us in carrying all things for campaign and to carry people to water for baptism.

Our preachers are in serious financial needs, and they really need your prayers.

I visited with Pastor Jackson Korkollie at the Saint Faith Church Of Christ last Sunday, and he took us through the Bible during Sunday School class.

The Church is under a serious lawsuit threat by some family members based in America who are claiming that the two town lots on which the Church is situated are theirs, and that it was sold illegally.



Cases like this here, either the church loses such place, rebuy or be relocated and relocation depends if those who are claiming should have another area. All of these will be terrible situation for the church and they will have no future because this land was bought by Dad in 2007.
