Junior is still working at his liquid soap business, but he has learned over the last year the situation in Haiti does not bode well for young entrepreneurs. He was able to sit in on a recent training conference and loved it. This is a 4 year program. We need help sending him to this school. The cost per month will be \$265. He will also need a laptop.

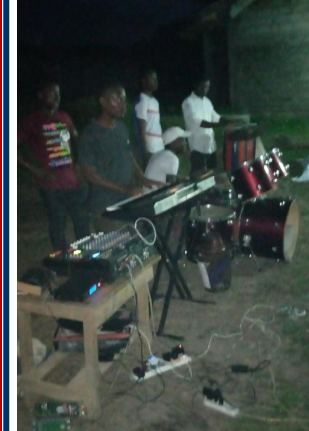

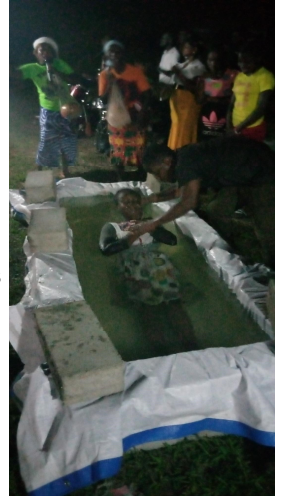
## 24 Baptized at Night Crusades in Liberia

## Children's Ministry



For as long as I can remember there has been a controversy over "orphanages". Whether it be over the different names to call the place (orphanage, home, safe house, etc.), to have a place to keep children or not, or what to do with children who needed help. This came up in Haiti after the earthquake. A lot of things changed that day. We have worked very hard to comply with social services rules. We are in good standing. But behind the scenes there is still a harsh anti orphanage movement.



Mid February there was a large fire at an orphanage in Kenscoff, Haiti. 18 children and two adults died because of the fire. Instead of thinking about and grieving for the children, this

fueled fire to the anti-orphanage movement. Below is the response Zane had for this tremendous loss.

I have many reasons for posting this. First off please keep the children who made it out in your prayers. The children who are not in hospitals have been placed in safe homes. Unfortunately some of the children that are in the hospitals are not expected to live, please pray for them. There are social workers working with the children.

There are individuals and organizations that have been posting information on this tragic accident that is not true. Church of Bible Understanding(CBU) that started this orphanage is not a church, but a cult. I remember studying about them in my Religious Cults class in college. They lost accreditation in Haiti for this orphanage, but it continued to operate. There are those that say they were still being funded by this US based church funded organization that takes in \$6 million a year. First off that is what CBU brings in for themselves and not the orphanage. Also although CBU claims to support this orphanage, they haven't been supporting for a long time. We know people in Haiti that have been helping this orphanage with different things for the children. Some had been trying reunite children with family if they had any. I just want everyone to get their information correct and please pray for these children

Now because of this tragic accident there are those back on their soapbox stating that all orphanages are this way and need to be shut down. It is said that 80% of children in orphanages are not true orphans and need to be reunited with their families. I'm all for reunification IF IT IS POSSIBLE. We only take in children in our homes that are brought to us by the police and social services and some of these children do have families. But because of sexual and physical abuse they can not stay there. Also if children don't have parents, there could be aunts and uncles, but this doesn't always work either. The family will take in their nieces or nephews and they become a restavek or domestic servant. There are even parents that send their children to families in hopes of a better future for them and they become restaveks in those families.

Unfortunately this is being done by individuals and organizations. Most of them have no idea about life in Haiti, they just think they do. Many of them sit in their homes above Port-au-Prince looking out on the city. They have not been to Cité Soleil ( the worst slum in Haiti) or out to the rural areas of Haiti to see how people live.



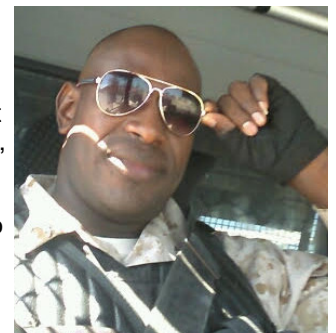

The IBESR (Social Services) in Haiti are working on things, but they don't have the right answers either. The IBESR is corrupt in themselves, because some of these orphanages that need to closed have paid bribe money for them to look the other way. So at the moment there are no answers.

Individuals and these organizations talk about all the bad growing up in an orphanage, but they don't tell you of the children that have come out to be productive members of society. We have many stories of this from us and others that we work with.

I've always have said and will continue to say that if you are supporting an orphanage or really any work that you support that you might have questions on. GO!!!!!! Make a surprise visit!!! They won't care if there is nothing to hide. We have had people in Haiti just show up unannounced and we have no problem with that, we actually appreciate it. What I am saying is don't stop supporting something just on someone else's word. CHECK IT OUT FOR YOURSELF!!!

Sorry this is so long and I'm done ranting but one last thing. Almost 100% of everyone's post on this tragic accident has been assigning blame on this and not thinking of the children. You can blame all you want, but don't forget the children that went through this. PLEASE, PLEASE KEEP THEM IN YOUR PRAYERS.

We wanted to mention this because there have been some ministries to lead this charge and have publicly said they want to get to every person who supports children in Haiti to be aware and to re-think their support. We want you to know we are in compliance, in good standing, and most of all, we want you to know that your support is needed, valued, and to know that in fact you are helping children to have a good home, education, food, clothing and especially learning the love of Christ. We do have stories of children who have grown up with us who are now leading successful, happy lives: lives they never thought were possible.





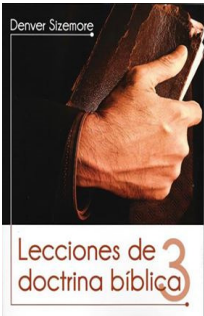
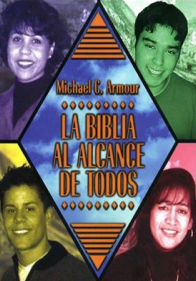
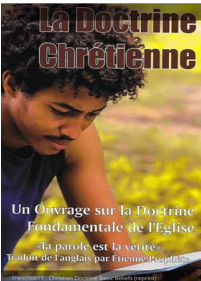
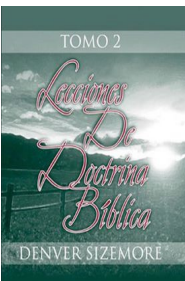
# New Project... Buying Books
