We thank you all again so much for the support that you gave to us and our Ministries, meaning the Orphanage and the Preachers in the Towns and Villages.

The Reggie Thomas Academy received two sets of Jerseys from the Anna M. Enoch Orphanage today. The students were so happy because they have to go to Buchanan City, Grand Bassa County for a friendly match with a School that invited us as a School.

We want to put a Basketball Court on the school Campus. We have purchased some bags of cement to begin the foundation. We will include Volleyball poles and net on the court also. Please join us in prayers. We want to encourage them to stay on the Campus and not run around free when they are not studying.

Please join us to pray for our students who are going this month to sit the Government Exam in Six grade. The Twelfth Graders will go in August. We need prayers because the test is drawn for the whole of West Africa.

It is now time for the rains to come down here in Liberia. Most of the churches will have problems with the attendance of the memberships. We need prayer for the members who are going to the farm in the Villages and Towns in the interior. Some of them sleep on the farm and come late to church while some stay away for the farm work. They need more encouragement to serve the Lord more.

As the roads are spoiling again, the preachers who do not have motorcycles are facing problems with getting to their churches on time due to transportation. Some of them are in Town that vehicles do not reach during the rains. Please pray with us for the preachers who do not have motorcycles.

We had a Leadership Seminar for our preachers in Montserrado, Bong, Margibi, Grand Bassa and Bomi Counties on Friday and Saturday July 2nd and 3rd. It was good to teach them "How to plant churches," "The Leader's inner life" and "Loyalty and Disloyalty," the topic was "Dangerous sons." We are going to Ganta on the 14th of July to have the same Seminar for all the preachers in Nimba and Guinea for two days. Pray with us.

We thank and appreciate all of you for your prayers and support to us and our Ministries. This month is our Independence Day month, to be specific the 26th. Our Country is 174 years old but it is still under development. Even the road to my Village in Bong County is cut completely by mid that only truck and motorcycle can pass through.

The Six Graders have not taken their Exam because some of the Examiners who were going to Maryland on a boat got drown. They were six among the 21 Passengers and 11 have been found as the rescue Team is still searching for survivors. Pray with us for them. The Ninth and Twelfth Graders have to take theirs also.

The children are all well and fine. My wife Anna is the person who is not really well due to the diabetes that has been giving her hard time. She is still reduced. Please pray with us for her health to improve.

Many happy greetings come to you all in the previous name of Jesus Christ our Lord. We went to Nimba County, Ganta to be specific for the Pastors Seminar which was held for two days. We had a good time of Bible teaching which fired up the preachers. I preacher in the Central church on Sunday the 18th and two men were baptized.

## Report From Uday

**Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will Help you, I will Uphold you with my Righteous Right Hand”**

**“Heal me, Lord, and I will be healed; Save me and I will be saved, for you are the One I Praise”**

On 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 I went to the hospital. Doctors examined my blood pressure and tested me, then they performed laser surgery on my varicose veins on both my legs successfully. They discharged me on the same day by packing with 4-layer bandage. Doctor prescribed medicine and two types of Injections for ten days. Doctor suggested that I have to take one month rest. On Sunday I didn't go to the church service in Kalahasti. I asked one my preacher Sudhakar, please go and perform church service. He accepted my request and conducted Sunday Church service. After 5 days I was at 60 percent recovered from my illness. The wounds are healing in a good manner through the heavy dosage of antibiotics.



On 16<sup>th</sup> day I have to attend one of our preacher, Vijay Kumar, daughter's wedding ceremony, which is 80 kilometers from my place. I thought that I am now better so I joined in the wedding ceremony. After that, on 18<sup>th</sup> day again I travelled by bus to Kalahasti to perform Sunday Church Service. But this time, my right thigh was having severe spasms, because of the road condition. Slowly it became swollen and formed blood clots. The very next day I was not able to walk and my right thigh severely damaged and not able to move.

I visited doctor and he examined through blood test. He found there is a blood clot, swollen and one third of liquid is formed in my right thigh. The Doctor again prescribed lots of medicine and injections (Anticoagulant shots for 10days – each twice a day). I suffered many nights without proper sleep and lots of pain. Now I am little bit better, but pain is not yet reduced. I am requesting you please pray for my quick recovery. This past Sunday I was not able to attend and perform the Church Service. My

heart filled with sadness because I am not able to go villages and church service. I know Our Lord is so good and He will take care of me. He will clear all my problems and again I am going to serve the Lord with full of health, joy and strength. I need a motorcycle for Ministry purpose.



**\*\*Before Uday had surgery he went out to help with Covid relief. He visited 17 preachers and their families. He was able to give them food. He also oversaw the building of a baptismal tank and repairs to 10 mile church.**
