We move to Kpatuo Nimba where we planted a church. We were on our way to Sanniquillie when the country was locked down and we returned to Monrovia. A new church was planted in Ganta, New Wuo's Town called Third Charity, Ganta City. That means three new Charity Churches were planted in 2020. We also visited Margibi County, Grand Bassa County, we had Crusades in Gbah's Town, Number One Compound and Big Joe Town in Buchanan City. Due to the Covid-19 we were forced to stop the trips out of town.

We bought a lot of land for 2nd Charity Church of Christ where a foundation was started. The walls are yet to go up due to lack of funds. Please join us in prayer for their building.

The Central Church in Ganta has reached roof level with no funds to complete it. The roof and floors with plastering needs your prayers.

The Charity Church in Ghaapa, Guinea has built their church to roof level also needing roofing materials, with floors and plastering. Please pray for them.

We have three of our children in the medical field, two in a Medical College while one is in a Medical Institute after which he will continue his study. Please pray with us for them because they will be working in the New Health Center when completed. This is the Senior year for Hanna and Samuel.

We now have 33 Charity Churches that are operating here in Africa. Two in Guinea and 31 in 6 of Liberia's fifteen Counties. Keep us in prayers for more support for the men that are on the fields as some of them need some help to remain at the battle front.

We concluded the year with our Annual Convention that was held in Monrovia at the Central Church. Funds collected was given to 3rd Charity in Upper Caldwell to get a parcel of land to build a building. In that Convention some people were baptized. We planned to take it to Ganta in 2021 by the grace of God.

We thank you and all our kind sponsors who kept us in the fields for the Lord through the year. We pray that the Lord will bless you all continually.

We managed to school over 400 children from Christian families that were unable to pay for school.

This is a summary report reflecting the year 2020. The year (2020) under review can be best described/characterized as a year filled with grieve, tragedies, massive deaths, sorrows, pains, sicknesses, non achievements etc, it will forever be remembered in the history of our existence, nevertheless all glory belongs to the Almighty God, He is the real and only true meaning/reason we are still counted among the living today.

My heart and prayers goes out to the many families and friends who have been directly or indirectly affected by this deadly virus especially those who have lost family & love ones.

I am also very much grateful to all our Christian friends/prayer partners, especially our supporters who continued to send us financial assistance through White Fields, may God richly reward your goodwill toward us and our families for the propagation of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.

During the year under review our church doors remain open for the most part except for April & May at which time had to go into lockdown due to the COVID-19. Church meetings during those periods were banned, all fellowships were conducted in our homes. Churches were again allowed to resume partially only on Sundays due to the curfew, gradually our weekly activities were restored as the curfew relaxed. All of our schedule outdoor activities including communities' revivals were cancelled due to the COVID-19 restrictions, however by the grace of God we were able to conduct three days indoor revival at the church between November 25 to 27.

All regular church activities including the observance of the Lord's supper, teaching/preaching, adult Sunday schools & prayer meeting were constant. We had three baptisms, all female adults and by the grace of God there have been no COVID-19 related cases within our church membership neither within our families, sadly we lost one of our adult female members as a result of a tragic car accident.

While it's true that the virus situation in our country has not been severe as compared to other countries including the USA, our economic conditions worsened, prices of basic goods and commodities have sky rocked in an unprecedented wave, creating an extreme and unbearable level of daily hardship.

Our biggest challenges and prayer requests are as follows:

\*Sponsors/financial supporters continuously for us & family.

\*A favorable respond from our landlady to our request for a renewal/extension of our church least agreement to enable us continue our church services unhindered and uninterrupted.

\*The next and also very important on our prayer list is the funds needed to secure another lease, our church income is very low and can barely take care of the weekly running of the church, 98 percent of our membership are unemployed and have no stable means of income.

\*Finally on our prayer list is the construction of the church building on the Church owned property located within the township of Brewerville, some couples of miles outside of Monrovia, this parcel of land (one lot) was purchased in 2007 (again through the help/effort of the late Evangelist Reggie Thomas who help raised the funds) however we could not start any work there as the place was still bush and uninhabited, currently a fast growing community is developing there and I think time is right for us to start a local fellowship/church there.

We will be directing most of our time, prayers & effort on this project come 2021, we have been praying for financial support over the past years for this project. We have also been saving up from our offering every penny we could spare for this project. We haven't yet received any financial help or commitment but we are determine to kick start the project with the little we have save as a first step of faith & trust in God's ability to make way for the funds/materials needed for this worthy Christian venture.
