Why We Do What We Do...



Junior Delphin came to the Jesus Loves Me Home when he was 2. As Junior grew, I could tell there was something special about him. He was so caring and had a heart for everything. He was the first to volunteer, to work, to help and the last to receive gifts, toys, and food. Junior loved all of the other children at Jesus Loves Me Home and was often taking care of the younger children. He considers himself blessed.



Fifteen years ago I started praying for Junior to desire and crave to be God's servant. I asked for God to lead him and to continue growing Junior's compassionate heart. Little did I know where God was going to lead.

Junior is now 28 years old. He works in the church, He is studying very hard to become a social worker. He wants to help all the children of Haiti. He rents a room in a large house.

On June 16, I received an urgent message from Junior. A lady who lives in the same house knew Junior is a Christian, grew up in an orphanage, and that he has a servant's heart. She came to him hoping he could help.

In the late hours of June 15 or early the 16th, a lady in Enery gave birth to a baby boy. For whatever reason she left the baby in the weeds. Junior's friend's sister happened to be walking by and found the baby suffering. She couldn't leave the baby, she called her sister, who then talked to Junior. They decided the baby needed to go to the hospital immediately.

God has already prepared Junior's heart for this baby. Junior has been at the hospital with this baby, praying over him and loving him, day and night. The baby was on oxygen for a week and his levels will have to be watched, otherwise he is perfectly healthy and released from the hospital.

Now what? No one has stepped forward to claim the baby. Jesus loves Me Home is not equipped for newborns. Junior loves the baby already and has decided he wants to keep the baby and has started the legal paperwork. The baby is named Carlens Junior Delphin. Without Junior, Carlens has no one. Junior's heart is so big he cannot turn away from this baby.



Your help is needed! Junior needs prayer! This is a huge undertaking for a single, 28 year old student! Prayer is needed for Carlens health. I'm sure the birth mother needs prayer too. Junior also needs financial help for Carlens (milk, diapers, clothes, etc), \$150-\$200 a month is needed. We also need to buy one time supplies for Junior. If the Holy Spirit leads your heart, please help.

The building project is on course by the grace of God; though the rain continues to post very challenging (we are now experiencing heavy down pour) not withstanding we are doing all we can to meet the challenge by His grace. I am praying that if everything goes well, depending on the weather condition, by the grace of God we may hopefully be able to reach the building at roof level by next week.

Please convey my best of regards to our sponsors, my family and I remain very much grateful to them for the monthly financial support towards our welfare.

I continue to pray for God to grant you good health and strength as you endeavor in prayer and advocacies to raise help/support for us for the advancement of our Lord's Kingdom.

Please pray along with us, our church membership/attendance have been very discouraging during this month, I have been making a lot of follow up calls and visits, some church members have been staying away from fellowship with no genuine reasons/excuse as some frankly admit.

Please pray for Roland. I was only able to visit our church project site today. I was diagnosed of severe respiratory tract infections and tested positive for malaria and typhoid fever. My health condition is gradually improving as I am responding to treatment, the typhoid fever test results is now slowly/weakly reactive and the malaria is said to be occasional, however I still have some difficulties breathing freely and I'm still coughing a lot. Please keep me in prayer, also I have been experiencing severe pain in my lower right colon for nearly 5 weeks it gets so tense during and especially after preaching/teaching sometimes my head is dizzy and I have to sit for like 5 to 10 mins. I went for medical test and advice the doctor could not establish the



cost but suggested that I need advance medical check up for possible kidney problem or maybe appendicitis, but right now the covid virus situation in our country is so alarming, that making hospitals calls very difficult and our health delivery system is at it's worst

News From Cuba

In my latest communication with Cuba, I asked if things were getting better in Cuba. Here is a response:

Noooo worst each day. There is almost nothing. It is terrible, but we are in peace and joy, thanks to our Lord.

Thanks so much, in this moment only pray for us. The situation is very complicated. It is impossible to explain our situation.

Some people are working according to their jobs, but the majority are in the house. The children don't go to the school and the churches are closed (only us have service). In May 2 policemen visited us and prohibited the service, but now we do that in our living room , but only 12 or 15 members.

The restaurants are not open, some of them only sell some food to carry home. There are some shops open to buy with card in USD or EUROS or Canadian dollars, but now since this week they don't permit to introduce dollar in your card and we can only get pesos anyway.

And there are some shops in Cuban PESOS but only have rum and water. But 2 times a week, more or less, they sell chicken only but the people are fighting for it . The same situation occurs in the USD shop. And the same in the pharmacy when they have some medicines.

Please continue to pray for Cuba. Also pray as we work to try to get help to the people there.
