

The churches have began to build their building to avoid serving in Town Halls which has been a major problem for the churches in the interior. I will attach some of the buildings for you to see.

The church that is in Ghaapa, Guinea has completed the walls and are now waiting for the metal sheets. They are needing 7 bundles of metal sheets. The church that is in Gipo has completed their walls and are appealing for 7 bundles. The church that is in Ganta has completed her wall and the timbers are up only waiting to be roofed. They need 18 bundles but they now have 8 on hand. They need a balance of 10 at \$90.00.

The church in the Villages' metal sheets cost \$65.00 each. Their walls cannot hold the heavy sheets because they use clay blocks. The church in Sewee has also completed their building and are waiting for the metal sheets. They also need 7 bundles that cost \$65.00 each. Please pray with us as the rain has began to fall here.

Please pray with us as we celebrate our 23rd Anniversary Thanksgiving on the 30th of May 2021. We are praying to change our ceiling in the church. It will cost us \$1000.00 to change the whole ceiling tile.

We are thankful to all of you for your prayers and support to us and our children and churches here in Liberia and Guinea. Especially your support to the orphanage is crucial in that it helps us to cater to all the children that we have here who attend school free on your accounts. Had you not been helping us with the Teachers salary the school will not be able to run. For the Physical Education uniforms, ID cards, notebooks, pencils and pens, school batch, etc. We are very grateful to God for all of you who help us in many other ways. The Lord will bless you continually.

Their education and their health, feeding and clothing through whatever you give to us we manage to do our best.

Many of our high schoolers with not further education. We need prayers for scholarship to help them go further in their quests to advance themselves. The Reggie Thomas Academy where they attend absolutely free is being supported by you by paying the Teachers.

The school needs two sets of jerseys for the Soccer Team and Kickball Team. They also need two Soccer balls. They jerseys cost \$150 per set while the Soccer balls cost \$25 each. Pray with us to help our kids to recreate and be happy. We have enough space for a Volleyball and Basketball courts. We only need help to prepare the court that will host both games. We have the net and the balls. We don't have the Basketball ring and poles to put them on. We need cement and sand to fix the court. Please pray with us.
