Haiti cannot seem to get away from turmoil. Once again I'm coming to you asking for prayers for all of our friends in Haiti. February 7th should have been the end of President Moise's term, but he says he still has one more year.



Elections have been cancelled multiple times and many say he is trying to be a dictator, but he says he is not a dictator. To fight him, influential people, including some in Parliament, provide ammunition and money to gang members. Moise is running the country by decree which is a violation of the constitution. As with every President that has been elected in Haiti, Moise has succumbed to enjoy the power of being President. The good thing with having a new President is that there is peace for a few years until the people grow tired of him/her.

Gang members in Haiti are ruthless and have proven many times they are very dangerous. In years past the rioting was violent too, but not like it is today. The gang members do not care who they kill. They will kill women, children, or anyone just to prove a point. They have instilled fear and the sense no one is safe. Also, Port-au-Prince was the "hot spot", rarely did the violence stretch out to the countryside, today it is nationwide.

Junior Delphin, who was robbed of his school money, tells me every day had bad things are in Gonaives. He has been having difficulty since his incident, so this round of violence has put him under a lot of stress and anxiety. He has said the gangs shut down the banks when they want and no one can get money. Sainsurin confirmed this and added the gangs are also shutting down the markets, schools and everyday there are shootings in the streets.

These are names of some of our friends, family, our children, and preachers. I wanted you to have names to pray for, but pray for the whole nation, I'm sur the Haitian people are tired, weary and want peace.

By the grace of God I am happy to inform you that the dedication of the church land and ground breaking ceremony was held this past Sunday and I am sending you photos. I've already mention/included in my last month (January) report; the final/complete estimate for the building from foundation to

roof (zinc) level (that was submitted by the masonry & carpenters with labor fee included) base in my request. I now have an estimated budget for the entire building project from foundation to roof/zinc level, the total cost have been place/projected at USD \$ 5,660. The building size is 50ft in length and 46ft in weight and carries 14 pillars.

The Saint Faith Church Of Christ land issue has now resulted to a repurchase. The real owner wants the church to pay 3000 USD after several years of negotiation. Some good friends of the church here were able to pay \$1500 after a heated argument that almost resulted in a fight and the balance of \$1500 to be paid April 2021.

We want to resume the crusades but our instruments were stolen last September and I told you about it; so it's reminder to keep us in prayer for God to provide \$950 so we can buy those needed instruments.

Please pray with us to get the mini bus for transportation to carry workers on the field. Crusades usually finish 8:30 pm to 9:00pm local time and can be unsafe for the workers who are making sacrifices to get their various homes. It's our prayers that God will provide \$ 9000 USD to get mini bus.

Also, please join us in prayer for our preachers who are still faithful, they really need help in the field.
