4. Widow Ministry

We work for the widows as well. There are about 120 widows in couple of villages. My wife meets with them and spends time in prayer and meditation of God's word. Occasionally we provide them some gift to share God's love in a practical manner.

5. Bible Distribution

We were able to distribute about 1000 Bibles in 4 district and this was a great blessing to be able to do through the help of Shepherd's purse. The ones who received the Bibles are new believers and it is an expression of love towards them. They are so excited to receive this precious gift.

6. Bible School

We are so thankful to God for enabling us to start a Bible School last year. 16 students started the one year training program but only 5 men successfully completed the training program and now they are in the mission field. They are really doing hard work as they go to different remote villages bicycle and some times by walk to preach the gospel to the unreached people. God is using them mightily and we are able to hear some great reports from these brothers.

7. Church Planting

We are also doing church planting ministry. We have several mission fields where our fellow brothers are working for the extension of God's Kingdom. We have 7 house churches where couple of families attend for the Sunday Worship, fasting prayer and other Bible study programs.

8. Sunday School

We are having Sunday school program mostly for the children in different villages. We help these children to grow in the Lord.

We are preparing for the 7th Annual Convention to be held in Ganta City, Nimba County. All the churches will be there for Bible teaching and preaching. We are praying for it to be a success.

Quincy Flomo from the church that is in Mao, Nimba County had an accident with his motor bike and was unconscious for almost a day. Thank God that he came through. The roads are very bad in the interior of our Country.

Continue to pray for the men that are on the field for the Lord. They need strength and wisdom from the Lord to do the Lord's work. Some of them find it hard especially when the rains begin to fall, their roads get very bad and vehicles do not go to some of the towns. Only motorcycles can go there.

Our joint revival services worked well when we visited four of our Churches three days a week. It was good to visit each church to encourage the members in the gospel of Jesus Christ. New people came into the churches as a result of the preaching. There were 41 baptisms this month.

Pray for Haiti



Every month now I have asked you to pray for Haiti. Each month it is for a different need or tragedy. This month is no different, except this month could have more of an impact on us and other foreigners in Haiti. A van holding 17 missionaries stopped to see an orphanage on the way to the airport. Once back in the vehicle and on their way, they were stopped by the 400 Mawozo gang and kidnapped. There are men, women & children, including a baby. There is a lot to be said about how this group did not follow protocol or take precaution but that is not the point.

This has now set a precedent for all mission and aid workers. The gang is demanding \$1 million per person and have said

they will start killing them one by one. Please pray for these missionaries. Pray for others there that they err on the side of caution and take all safety precautions.

Other missions and aid workers were praying for President Biden to send in an extraction team to get the kidnapped Americans, to set a precedent "do not attempt to kidnap Americans"! But according to Haiti news, he has sent in a negotiations team to work on the ransom! This WILL set a precedence but not in a good way. Pray for all foreigners in Haiti.

It is estimated by news sources that 2/3 of Haiti is now being ruled by gangs. People are scared, frustrated, and hurting. They are fed up! Gas is now \$25 a gallon off the streets, out of jars. Gas stations are closed because they cannot get enough gas. Junior has been going to Pignon to pick up items for the baby that we are able to get into him. This month he had to pay 3 times as much as he did 3 weeks ago. This fuel shortage will have an effect on our communication ability with Haiti. Pray for mercy for the Haitian people.

From Ronel:

We are doing well. The boys continue to enjoy their school. Despite of the difficulties of our country. The gangs abducted a bus with 17 American missionaries among which are three children. We have more kidnappings in Port-au-Prince than many places in the world that are well known for this practice according to some statistics. The gangs now kidnap anyone they can find, little vendors, big ones, students, pastors in the middle of serviceand so on, it is becoming worse now.

The gangs now take complete control over almost 50% of the capital where all our goods come from. We are having some shortage of food now...things are not looking good this time . Please pray for this country, the missionaries and other Haitians that are in the hands of the gangs. Please pray for the US government to make the right decision in this matter, to send the right help as the US influences anything we do here politically, which I believe is a big part of this crisis as this nation cannot freely choose whom to see can lead well the country...our votes haven't been counted for a long time, we are being imposed by our governments....please pray that we will be able to freely choose our leaders that one day the citizens of this country will love to vote as their votes will count....please prayyyyyyyyyyyyyyy



David's House

A couple months ago we were asked for help from Shepherd's Purse, another mission organization. They had work in India and in Eastern Europe. They have found themselves needing to focus on their work in Eastern Europe and asked us to take their work in India, David's House, under our wing. This work is already funded so we said we would help. We want to introduce you to David's House.

I am Joshua Nag, I am married to Savita Nag. God has blessed us with 3 sons Daniel, Isaac and Abiel.

It's indeed amazing to see how God has blessed White Fields ever since it started. I am richly blessed and encouraged by reading your story. I am so thankful to Sir Michael Wetzel, Executive Director of Shepherd's Purse for introducing us with you.

By the Grace of God currently we are doing these following ministries:

1. Orphanage

We thank God for the opportunity to be in the service of the Lord. We began our ministry here with an orphanage back in 2007. We registered an organization called 'More Than Enough Ministries' with a thought that Jesus is more than enough for us. The orphanage was started with 15 orphans and poor boys. We didn't have any regular source of finances to provide for the orphanage. God miraculously helped us to take care of the boys. Later on God brought Shepherd's Purse on our path through Pastor David Hendrix who is now with the Lord. Shepherds' Purse have been partnering with us and supporting us financially for the orphanage since 10 years. Now we have 24 boys in the orphanage. We are so thankful to Sir Michael Wetzel Executive Director and Executive Board of Shepherd's Purse for his great concern for India ministry. We also extend our thanks and gratitude towards all the sponsors who have been supporting our boys at the orphanage.

2. Children Tuition Center

We do work among the village kids who are so poor and unable to provide any education for them due to their poverty. We have started two children center where we teach them their school lesson as well as Bible stories, Christian songs, Bible verses and etc. There are about 150 children who have been blessed by this program. It's our prayer and desire that these kids may know and experience the love of Jesus in such a young age so that they may grow up as godly men and women.

3. Girls' Ministry

We work for the poor and orphan girls. These girls are from near by places. About 30 girls come to our orphanage building everyday. We teach them their school lesson and Bible stories and Christian songs. They spend here 2 hours everyday. they are growing in the knowledge of God's word and they are also learning their school subjects. These girls come from very poor family. Whenever it is possible we provide them some stationary items.
