I travelled to Toodee to conduct leadership training with Michael George, James Sackie and leaders with other invited churches. Due to rain, we didn't have crusade out doors but revivals and seminars.

When I was in Junction Town for leadership seminar last week, we had 11 baptisms. Please remember these souls in your prayers

This place is Junction Town where we did the recent baptisms during the seminar. Michael George told me that they couldn't finish the project because he had to give about 35% to the church members because they where hungry during the out break and the nation wide lock down. At this stage, \$2000 can roof this building and I promise that I will be there working along to see it done.

Junior has continued to amaze me throughout the years. One day we were in town, Junior had a few coins, the only money to his name, he gave it all to an elderly woman so she could buy a little rice for the day. Then as you know 3 months ago adopted a discarded newborn.

Adopting Carlens has set Junior's heart on fire to help his nation. Junior and I talk everyday and every day it is something new he can do to help. It is exciting to hear his thoughts. As he is studying to be a social worker, he is learning a lot and wishes to keep as many children with their families and help them learn to do good.

We know at the moment we are limited on monetary sources and we know his organization needs to start small and then grow, but he is starting and it is exciting.

With the help of the Reggie Thomas Scholarship Fund, Junior helped 5 poor children go to school this year. He asked the parents to contribute what they could for school uniforms, then he paid for the rest. He paid for their books, notebooks, shoes, school supplies, and school fees.

I asked Junior why he wanted to help: *"The reason I would like to help children is because growing up in an orphanage, I find people who were thinking for me and helping me so I also want to help to give more children help so that they do not fall into bad things so we have a better society."*

Junior has created a name and logo. He would like to have an after school program that would include homework help, learning useful skills, devotions, and more. He also wants to help in a lot of other ways as we are able to gain support for him.

Please pray for Junior and for his huge heart to be protected. Pray for the things he would like to do to help children stay with their families. We need help with this project, if God lays this on your heart.

Some of them have done their best with the timbers for the roofing. What they can get easily is the clay blocks and the timbers but the metal sheets they cannot afford. We need prayers for their roofing sheets.

Thank God that many souls came to the Lord last month in some of our Churches that organized weeks of prayer and revivals. We also organized joint revivals meetings amongst four of our Churches that are in Montserrado County. We spent three nights in a church and after a week, we go to the next church. We have completed Third and Fourth Charities. We are going to Second Charity next week and the last will be in the Central Church. Pray for us as we want to strengthen our people with the gospel message.

Pray for us as we prepare for the 7th Annual Convention to be held in Ganta City, Nimba County in December. It will not be easy to transport 10 churches from the four Counties from our end to go to Nimba County. We have to visit the churches in the dry seasons as usual. We preach and teach the people when we go out.

Every last Sunday, you will see the attendance reduce in Nimba County and Guinea and increase in one of the churches, that means, there the joint service was held. Last month, they were in Sewee church. They have their building up now. Thank God for them.



We thank God for the bus, the Lord provides us some money to repair it. I have called the Mechanic Man to come and see the bus tomorrow. He will begin to work on it tomorrow as he said. He will have to get an engine block because the previous one cracked.
