I took this Ministry from Dad, Reggie and my Father-in-Law's (Sathya) wish on 2010 onwards. From that period until now I am doing the Ministry work sincerely. My uncle Sathya and my Brother-in-law Jaya Kumar had constructed nearly or more than 40 church buildings. Sathya died in 2008 and Jaya Kumar died in 2010. During the period, we faced so many calamities like floods, heavy rains and cyclones. Some church buildings collapsed/destroyed and some buildings occupied by our old preachers. Now we have only 11 church buildings that are still going. These church buildings are very old and some churches like GK Palli Church, Vallivedu Church, Nagolu Church, Ramapuram Church, Vathuru Church and Kalahasti Church building. We need to construct 4-5 church buildings. I am requesting you please pray for us.



I need a motor bike for ministry work. I am requesting you please pray for me sister.

Around 10 years ago I saved one soul from this village. His name is Abraham. After some one-on-one, he accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and Saviour. Our Lord did so many miracles in this village. That's why many people believed and accepted Jesus Christ. Now the church members are worshipping in a small hut, but during the rainy season it is difficult to worship, because there is no such good roof over it. I requested to Dad Reggie and you for constructing new church building. Due to the financial constraints, it was delayed. Now another denominational people came to this village and they are asking to the church members, if they accept their conditions they will construct through their denomination. If it is possible, shall we construct the Church building? I am requesting you sister, please pray for us. I am requesting you please guide me sister.

In February month we the preachers and co-workers visited 15 villages and 120 houses and we prayed for them. We saved 9 souls and gave baptisms. I personally gave 3 baptisms in February month, after that I gifted the Holy Bibles to them. I am requesting you please pray for them.



In January I gave Baptism to both of them. After that I followed up and they are very happy, after accepting Jesus Christ.

We already have two lots of land there for the church.

They now need help to put up the building. They are presently serving in the Government School building. We intend to now extend to Jekeyeh, Laoula and Zerekoule since he speaks the French language fluently. He has Masters Degree in French. He interprets and translates in French.

Steven Enoch in Liberia, Africa



We have visited some of our Churches in Bomi, Margibi, Nimba and Guinea. We started with Gbah, Bomi County and Gbah's Town, Margibi County. We then left Monrovia for Bong, Nimba and Guinea on the 23rd of February, 2022. We slept in Ganta, Nimba County. We started with Tunudin, Nimba County where we baptized 48 persons.



We went on to Whenten where we baptized 15 persons into Christ. We only spent one night in each Town because they were many for us to visit. We then went to Whallah where we baptized 27 persons into

Christ. We went to Sewee the next day and baptized 20 persons into Christ. We left for Gipo still in Nimba County. This is the Town where the biggest scorpion visited us for the first the Crusade when we showed the video on the Second Coming of Christ. It appeared in the midst of the crowd and it was killed. We baptized 100 persons.

We moved to Gbeh Tengben where we baptized 29 persons. We moved to Ghampa, the Republic of Guinea where we baptized 42 people into Christ. We moved to Being Sonyee where we baptized 25 persons. We moved to Zuapa where another scorpion visited the Crusade and a live video was taken by me before it was killed. In the morning before we could leave for Ballah in the afternoon, Mother Marthalyne Enoch, Bro. Luke's wife was nearly stung by a scorpion. it was killed that morning. In Zuapa 47 people were baptized into Christ. We went to Ballah for the night service in which 29 persons were baptized that night. 11 were baptized on Sunday morning. Here again a scorpion visited the crowd from the back. It was killed by the young men. Because scorpions visit the Crusade, we cannot stop going out with the Word of God. We love to go out especially in the dry seasons. We can face a lot of difficulty on our trips. We need mostly transportation, food, and equipments for the services. The Crusade Team member need some help in the form of money to leave with their families before going out. We then came to a Town called Wheyepa after Ganta, Nimba where 29 persons got baptized into Christ.

We took our longest journey to Gbeh Bonah near the Ivorian border. We spent two nights there baptizing 53 persons into Christ. The total person baptized were 505 persons.

The churches are doing their best to acquire their own land and put up their own building as I continue to tell them.

Nengbeh church has found a lot of land for for \$500 USD. Please pray for them to get the land.
