

I am so thankful to you for your regular prayers. We the preachers, co-workers and my family members are also praying for you Sister.

Here we are facing some difficulties to find out the place to construct a church building in Anjuru Village. The Hindu people are refusing to give the land in the village. No one is giving free of land for church building. We need to buy the land. But I am keep on searching for the free land/place. Once I got the free land, then I will ask you to build the church building. Sister, I am requesting you please pray for Anjuru Church.

ANNUAL EXAMINATION: - Thank God and thanks all of you for your prayer and support for our orphanage boys. They have an opportunity to get good education and make their good career through your support. We thank God that the boys appeared their annual examination and secured good grade and promoted to the next class. God provided all their educational need and basic needs in the previous time. God is so good and His faithfulness endures forever.

HEART ISSUES: - Thank God and the donors for their prayer and support for one of our orphanage boys who is sick from heart issues. We are giving him the treatment and By God's help he is doing little better. He needs to take medicine for long period.

Ministry Report:-

Church planting: - By God's grace the Church planting ministry is going well. At present 8 Evangelists (former Bible College graduates 5 and present Bible college students 3) are doing ministry in different villages. They go to their ministry villages every Sunday to conduct the prayer and worship and visit families with the word of God. Please pray for these Pastors and their families that God may continually use them for His service and bring people from darkness to light.

Bible College: - By the grace of God the Bible college is going on well and the students are coming to the regularly. They have been learning about God's word and preparing themselves for His ministry. 3 students have joined in this batch.

Children ministry in the villages: - By God's grace the children ministry is going well in the villages. We are going those areas and sharing the children about God's word. We thank God we were able to feed them one time in this month. Children are so excited.

Bible distribution: - It has been several years that we were not able to reach out with distributing the Bible. Lord willing and if God provides we will distribute.

Widow ministry: - Thank God that the widows those who are associated with us are doing well. We are able to reach them frequently with God's word. We had a widow meeting in this month and we praised and worshiped with them. Also God helped us to give them some food and clothes.

Orphanage (DAVID'S HOUSE):- By God's grace the orphanage is going well. We have 24 boys at the orphanage. They are doing well with their studies. They are very happy because they all are promoted to the new classes. They are growing in the Lord. God is meeting their daily needs. Always our boys are thankful to God for His wonderful deeds in their lives. It's only His grace for the boys what they are now.

Girl's ministry: - We have an opportunity to do ministry for the street girls. They are coming to our orphanage house everyday and we are teaching them the love of Jesus and their school lessons. They are very poor. The girls are learning from the Bible and we see some changes in their lives.

Sunday school ministry: - We thank that the Lord is enabling us to conduct the Sunday school for the children. They are learning here about God's word, songs, dance and memory verses and the Bible stories.

Prayer points:-

- Please pray for the school supplies, admission fees and uniforms for our orphanage boys. We are in need total cost \$5000 (raised \$1100 and still lacking \$3900)
- Please pray for the house rent for the 2 village children school. We have taken room rent in two villages to conduct the class for the children. Per month \$200. We are on due \$ 1500 for previous month's rent.
- Please pray for the construction to be completed of the second story of the Orphanage building.
- Please pray for all the orphanage boys for their monthly support.
- Please pray for 150 Bible (\$800) for the village kids and street girls.
- Please pray for our Pastors and their families that God may continually use them for His work and provide them their daily basic needs.

News from Liberia

Roland McGill continued:

I am also very happy to report that God have given us breakthrough with OUR LANDLADY and the first payment of four hundred & eighty (\$ 480 USD) FOR TWELVE MONTHS (February – 2022 to January 2023) have been agreed and paid with the understanding that additional two years be paid in the next five (5) months period.

With regard to our church project in Brewerville, we have so far been able to procure around 60% percent of the planks/timbers needed for the roofing I'm hoping we can get the builders to start/put up the first consignment.

Steven Enoch:

We are thankful to the Lord for the churches that have managed to put up their structures. There are five churches that have put up their buildings. Two used cement to Clay while three used Clay to Clay which is very difficult to do when the rain is coming down now. The two that are in Guinea are the Zuapa church and the church that is in Ghaapa. Tunudin, Boapea and Mao the last are all in Nimba County. Their main problems have been the roofing material. We continue to pray for them.

We will be going to Ganta City for three days of Bible training and Seminar for all the Preachers of our Churches on June 7th to 9th. Please pray with us for the printing of the materials and transportation for the men that are in the Counties to get to Ganta which is about six hour drive from Monrovia.

My team reports 24 baptisms.

2. Hannah Nelson is about to graduate with Samuel from the same College. She is on her affiliation in Sinoe County. Her graduation fee is \$700.
3. Wesseh Myers is also doing his BSC now in a College where he is paying \$200 per Semester.
4. Madaweh Myers and Lydia David are in a Nursing College where they are paying \$250 per semester each of them.
