In January we the preachers and co-workers baptized 25 and gifted Holy Bibles to them. We visited 80 households.

Here again Covid-19 Virus (Delta + Omicron Viruses) are in peak stage. Every day 2000 people are getting infected through this virus. But fortunately, death cases are registering very less in number. Our government distributed vaccines to everyone for free. We are all vaccinated two doses, now booster doses. Our government put some Covid -19 restrictions like mask wearing compulsory, night curfew and social distance in public places like in temples, churches, mosques, and public gatherings, etc.



The church members are also confused and fearing what is happening in and around the world. In November and December was filled with rains and cyclones. We the preachers suffered a lot. After that Corona virus playing a prominent role. The Church members are not coming regularly because of the pandemic distress.

I am not able to travel long distances, I need a motor bike for Ministry purpose.

We need to construct 3 new church buildings, because the newly converted believers are asking me regularly to construct the church building to worship Lord Jesus Christ.

Many thanks and appreciation to you and all our sponsors who continue to bless us with their resources to be able run the ministries here for the Lord. We always pray that the Lord will bless all of them as He plans to do for those who help the poor.

We thank the Lord for raising up the church that is in Ballah, Republic of Guinea. We now have Dion Jacque there taking care of the church. We have bought two lots of land there for the church but there is no building there yet. They started to worship in the Public School building on Sunday. The creeks are dried so 17 people who came up for baptism could not be baptized on Sunday. Let us pray for them. Bro. Dion speaks French fluently so it will be easy for them.

We have began our Yearly Crusade with the first one in Caldwell, New Georgia where we baptized 37 persons. From that area, four young men who are drug addicts got baptized on Sunday. There was real joy in the service as we danced before the Lord. Praise the Lord for them.

We went to Gbah, Bomu County where we baptized 4 persons. We also went to Gbah's Town, Margibi County for a night and a day service. Just keep us in prayers as we go out to the remote parts of our Country and Guinea.

We have planned to take the Campaign for Jesus Crusade Team again in February to Bong, Nimba Counties and Guinea. We will by the help of God plant a new church in Zoweinta, Bong County.

We are going to visit most of our Churches in Nimba and Bong Counties. We will spend one night each in the Towns where we will go because we want to visit most of them as much as possible. Our prayer is for the trip expenses. As I write gasoline price has gone up to \$5.50 US per gallon. We will use more than 70 gallons because we will use the generator for lights at night and go from town to town until we enter into Guinea. The trip back is not easy.

Our amplifier is spoiled now and we need your prayers. The church's drum is spoiled making it hard to go without a drum which encourages people. Prayer is needed for a new set. Africans are encouraged by music and the instruments. They love to dance for the Lord.

We have replaced Bro. Mark Luogon with Henry Keah in 2nd Charity Church of Christ Int'l, He has moved to Johnsonville outside Monrovia.

The churches in Nimba are trying to put up their buildings in this dry season. The problem that they are having is with the metal sheets to cover the buildings to avoid the rains from spoiling the walls. Please pray with us for their works.

We really need prayers for the Crusade Team members to get some help because they leave the City and go out into the bushes for the Word of God. When they return, their little businesses have gone down for lack of funds. If we can get some help to give to them they will be happy to go. Many of the Team members are staying away from the trips. Please join us to pray for some help for them.

PRAISE POINTS:-

CHRISTMAS CLOTHES FOR THE ORPHANAGE BOYS: - The orphanage boys get clothes once in every year in Christmas season by which they wear for whole year. We were praying for these needs in last Christmas time too. We thank God that He provided the needs and we were able to distribute them and the boys are so happy and have been wearing them. We also provided shoes and socks. It is very useful for them.

CHRISTMAS PROGRAM CONDUCTED AT THE ORPHANAGE: - God is so good and provided the necessary finances to conduct the Christmas program at the Orphanage for the boys, staff and the street girls. All the performances went well and children are so excited for this. The children did dance, skits, memory verses and sang. We thank God for His provision.

MINISTRY ACTIVITIES:-

Church planting: - By God's grace the Church planting ministry is going well. 5 number of Evangelists (former Bible College graduates) are doing ministry in different villages. They go to their ministry villages every Sunday to conduct the prayer and worship and visit families with the Word of God. Please pray for these Pastors and their families that God may continually use them for His service and bring people from dark to light.

Bible School: - By God's grace the Bible College has begun for the second batch and the students have joined. The classes are going well and the students are doing well with their studies and preparing themselves for the Lord's ministry.

Children ministry in the villages: - We thank God for His blessings in the ministry. By His grace the village kids are coming to the class everyday from Monday to Friday since 9.00am to 11.00am. Currently we have 2 children centers in the 2 different villages. There are 150 students. We teach them about God's word and their school lessons. They are slowly growing in the Lord. The children are poor. We had Christmas program in this village to share the good news of Jesus.

Bible distribution: - It has been several years that we were not able to reach out with distributing the Bible. Lord willing and if God provides we will distribute.

Widow ministry: - Praise God that my wife is doing ministry among the widows and encouraging them with the Word of God. They are growing in prayer life and trusting upon Jesus.

Orphanage (DAVID'S HOUSE):- We thank and praise God that the orphanage is going well. Now we have 24 boys. They are studying well in their classes. They are preparing for their annual examination which will be held in the month of March. They are growing in spiritually and educationally. They fear God. They are getting their daily food and other needs. The boys are so happy by residing here and they are so much thankful to all of you. The boys are praying for you.

Girl's ministry: - We have an opportunity to do ministry for the street girls. They are coming to our orphanage house everyday and we are teaching them the love of Jesus and their school lessons. They are very poor. The girls are learning from the Bible and we see some changes in their lives.

Sunday school ministry: - We thank that the Lord is enabling us to conduct the Sunday school for the children. They are learning here about God's word, songs, dance and memory verses and the Bible stories.

Prayer points:-

- Please pray for the house rent for the 2 village children school. We have taken room rent in two villages to conduct the class for the children. Per month \$200. We are on due \$1300 for previous month's rent.

- Please pray for 150 Bible (\$800) for the village kids and street girls.
- Please pray for our Pastors and their families that God may continually use them for His work and provide them their daily basic needs.
