The Mapou Christian Orphanage opened its doors in 1978. In 1995, because of circumstances beyond our control, the orphanage was relocated to Gonaives and the name changed to Jesus Loves Me Home. We have helped thousands of children throughout the years.

Once again we find ourselves at a crossroads and ask for you to pray for the future of Jesus Loves Me Home and wisdom for us to seek God's will.

Throughout the years things in Haiti have been changing and evolving. Because we are properly registered with the Government, we are at the mercy of IBESR (social services). IBESR has a handbook of rules that we must try to follow. Some of these rules are good, but a lot of them are not good and really difficult to follow. With IBESR alone it would be easy to throw our hands up and say forget it, many have! Also prices of items keep rising and each month more expensive. One last thing, Prospere and Clotide are at retirement age, upper 60s and old for Haiti's lifespan. They have reached a point that taking care of 20 plus children is difficult.

But the children of Haiti still needs help from all of us! They still need food, education, housing, but as Haiti changes we have found there are many, many other needs the children need met at this time in Haiti. Example: As they get older, they need something constructive to do during their free time to learn skills and to stay away from gangs.

We look forward to the future with joy, but at this moment do not know what the future looks like. Please pray:

- ◆ We can find new, young, Christian administrators
- ◆ Clear path we take for the future
- ◆ For the children during any transition
- ◆ Continued/more funding to help the children

answers to that such as money, food, peer pressure, survival, etc. The number one reason is these kids do not have God in their lives.



The parents, unfortunately, are having to put all their time and energy into putting food on the table every day, so they do not have the time. A camp that these kids could come to each every year of their childhood would definitely help in keeping them on the right path.

There are also many kids in Haiti with disabilities that are not afforded the same opportunities as the other kids. These kids would be able to come and build relationships with other kids like them and be able to build their relationships with God.

We really would like to find some beachfront property, because then we could add in another phase of the camp. During the weeks that there are no camps, then it would be open for people to come and stay, eat, and relax at the beach. There are two positives for this. One would be the money made would be able to help fund the camp and be used for upkeep of the camp.

The second would be that we would be able to bring in Haitians to work and train them in hospitality. Haitians who are experienced and able to work in hospitality make good money because they can receive tips with their salaries. This would be an excellent opportunity to help Haitians learn a trade to better their lives.

This is a project that will take time and money depending on if we buy land and build on it or if we are able to buy property with existing buildings on it. Unfortunately, we do not have a set price in mind because of prices in Haiti are always changing. If property were able to come available then you must jump on it, because it will not be listed for long. That is why we want to go ahead and start raising money to put in a fund for this project. We are in the process of at least trying to get prices on properties and will update in the next newsletter. Please keep this in your prayers!



A Letter from Ukraine

Shared from Rick & Della Deighton

"Dear Rick and Della,

Our life has changed to the point that it is really hard to describe in one letter. It has been already the 52nd day of terrible suffering. On the one hand we wake up every morning and think of the past, and our happy life in Kharkiv, but on the other hand we cannot even think of what the future has for us. We just live day by day since the 24th of February. (The day Putin ordered Russian troops to attack.)



Our older kids, Mary and Yan, happen to be in Austria. When shelling began in Kharkiv and after living in subway for a week, we put them on the train and sent them to Austria. My friends from TCM in Austria helped them. They plan to enter schools there. Next week my wife and youngest son Jacob will join them. Natasha and Jacob were here with me in Carpathian Mountains for a month, but we made a decision for her to go. We had moved to Carpathian Mountains the next day by car with Natasha and Jacob after we had sent kids away by train.

By miracle of God, my parents (85 years old) evacuated from Kharkiv by train and I was able to meet them in Ternopol (close city to where we are) and bring them to Carpathian Mountains after their house in the countryside of Kharkiv was attacked. They spent 24 hours on the train sitting. Here we were able to receive a conclusion from doctor for them as they need extra help in caring.

It is Palm Sunday here and I wish you and your family many blessings of resurrection. I am serving here in a local evangelical church and the pastor asked me to preach every Sunday. Tomorrow, Monday, I need to go to the military department. Based on the documents I have from the doctors, they should let me take care of my parents and not enlist me into Army. **I need prayers for their hearts to be open to do that. Please pray for me.**

May the Lord Jesus bless you and give us His peace, Zhenya and Family"
